Sir,

In producing herewith the following 03 (three) persons arrested namely i) Makhan Bhakta (32) S/O Lt. Jagadish Bhakta of Madani Bazar, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri, ii) Pranab Saha (38) SO- Late Mona Saha of Madani Bazar, Baribhasa, Teng Bhaga More, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri iii) Bikash Sankar (29) SO- Akhil Sankar of Shipaipara, Canal Road, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri under arrest along with the following seized articles:-

1. One (01) axe measuring approx 18" in length with Bamboo handle.
2. One (01) sword measuring approx 24" in length with wooden handle.
3. One (01) iron made hammer measuring approx 12" in length with bamboo handle.
4. One (01) Electric torch light blue in colour.
5. One (01) nylon rope.

I, S.I Tanmoy Kundu presently attached with New Jalpaiguri Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate would like to lodge this written complaint against the above noted persons and 4/5 others persons to the effect that today i.e on 22/02.03.2026 at about 00.05 hours when myself along with ASI Khagen Barman, C/453 Uttam Dey, C/1462 Sajan Tamang, VP 13 Jamirul Islam, VP/08 Laxman Roy was performing night mobile duty at that time received a secret source information over telephone that a group of 10/12 persons had assembled at Kashmir Colony Ucha Math, under NJP P.S with deadly weapons with a view to commit some heinous crime. Accordingly without waste any time I informed the matter to you and diarized the fact in GDE vide NJP PS GDE No 1028 Dated 22/03/2026. As per your kind direction and instruction we rushed to the spot to verify the veracity of the information and to work upon it. On way to the P.O I managed two independent witnesses namely i. Sonu Mahato, S/O Jaglal Mahato of Tinbatti Colony, P.S- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri, ii. Subhajit Adhikari SO- Shbu Adhikari of Tinbatti Colony, P.S- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri whom we disclosed our motto and identity and asked them to accompany us if any search and seizure is necessary for the purpose. We reached near the spot as directed by the source at about 01.10 hours and stopped at a considerable distance and we started walking towards them that no one could anticipate our movement and found a group of 07/09 persons sitting there. We started approaching towards them slowly ambushing ourselves in the darkness. But unfortunately one of the them saw us and shouted "Police" at the top of his voice.

Thereafter all of them started fleeing away. Anyhow, after a hot chase we could able to apprehend the 03(three) above referred accused persons. On interrogation the 03(three) persons disclosed their identity as noted above and confessed 07/09 other persons with them. They had assembled there with a view to commit dacoity after making full preparation adjacent areas. Thereafter all the apprehended persons were searched in presence of the witnesses and the above noted articles were seized from their possession. The whole process of search, seizure and arrest was made in between 01.30 hrs to 02.05 hrs on 22.03.2026 under proper videography.

Under the above circumstances, I pray before you that a specific case may kindly be started against the 03 (three) persons arrested nameily and 07/09 other persons under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation. Seized articles were handed over the Makhana Officer with proper seizure list after maintaining all formalities.
