Respected Sir,

I, SI Pintu Ghosh serving under your kind disposal filling this written complaint against 20/25 unknown youths of Bhaktinagar PS and in and out Siliguri area to the effect that on 27.03.2026 "Ram Navami" festival was being celebrated all over the West Bengal as well as in Siliguri. To maintain law and order duty an Police arrange made and I was performing K38 Morning patrolling van duty at Anchal More, Ward No. 42, Siliguri Municipal Corporation under Bhaktinagar PS area (which is also an intersection point) vide Bhaktinagar PS. CC No. 1244/2026 date: 27.03.2026 accompanied by C/828. Dulal Chandra Barman and C/1431. Dilip Barman all of Bhaktinagar PS, SPC from 07.50 hrs onwards date: 27.03.2026, also Police officers from traffic unit of Siliguri Police Commissionerate was deployed to maintain the free flow movement of traffic. In this festival a large numbers of public in general including male female and youngsters took part and they were divided into small groups and were going from Haider Para side to Siliguri through ISKCON Mandir Road via Anchal More with well decorated tableaux. Since after took up the duty things were going normal, several small numbers of "Ram Bhaktas" were coming toward Anchal More from Haidar Para and Ashighar area side by making procession with their well-decorated tableaux and all they cooperating Police and it was not causing any convenience to the public in general also the traffic movement was normal till time. At the duty post Sri. Rabin Thapa, ACP-SB II, Siliguri Police Commissionerate as a supervising officer for Bhaktinagar PS. SPC.

At around 13.15 hrs while I along with my force performing duty and helping the group of "Ram Bhaktas" to cross the congested place like Anchal More, Ward No. 42, Siliguri Municipal Corporation under Bhaktinagar PS then approx. 500/600 people/devotees were assembled there including public in general who were came to see the religious tableau. In between this approx. 20/25 Nos. of unknown youths all aged approx. 20 to 25 years coming from Ashighar Side by running and screaming they reached at Anchal More, it was surprising to the public in general as they were carrying raised sword in their hand. Such shouting and running around with raised sword in hand created an atmosphere of fear among the peaceful public & devotees. Considering the scenario without wasting any time myself along with force intervene immediately and started to identify and detain the

youths who are carrying raised weapon in their hands. Already approx. 500/600 people and devotees assembled at Anchal More where we were performing duty and all the 20 to 25 youths were dressed similar to the dress of devotees hence it became impossible to trace out the youths and by taking advantage of crowd they escaped from the place.

After this incident things are again became peaceful, devotees with well decorated tableaux, spectators and public in general together peacefully fulfilled their respective responsibilities. Except only those 20 to 25 unknown youths who defied the Calcutta High Court order (WPA No. 7511 of 2024 & WPA No. 6515 of 2026) and temporarily created a noisy atmosphere in the area by shouting and running around with raised sword in hand in the peaceful "Ram Navami" procession, and fled away from the scene with their swords, taking advantage of the crowd and after seeing Police action. Therefore after completion of duty myself submitting this written complainant and also I pray before you to start a specific case under proper sections of law against those approx. 20/25 Nos. of unknown youths and arrange for its investigation.
