Respected Sir,

I, SI Arup Singh presently posted at Siliguri PS under your kind disposal filing this written complainant against 45/50 unknown persons majority of them are youths of Siliguri PS and in and out Siliguri area to the effect that on 27.03.2026 "Ram Navami" festival was being celebrated all over the West Bengal as well as in Siliguri and in this regards an Police arrangement was made to maintain law and order duty. Accordingly, I along with other officers and force were deployed at Venus More under Siliguri PS area which is also an intersection point to perform Law and Order duty, vide Siliguri P.S M.C.C No. 846 date 27.03.2026 from 09:00 hrs onwards date 27.03.2026 and also Police officers and force from traffic unit of Siliguri Police Commissionerate were deployed at the same place to maintain the free flow of traffic. A large number of devotees including male, female and youngsters took part in this festival by dividing into small groups were coming from Tikiapara More, Court More and Panitanki More with well decorated tableaux and started moving towards Air View More, Siliguri via Venus More, Siliguri. Till 15:10 the situation was normal at Venus More area and also the traffic movement was normal till time as several small numbers of groups of devotees who were coming from various location of Siliguri and moving towards Airview More via Venus More with their well-decorated tableaux cooperating Police which convenience to the public in general as well as Traffic flow was normal till time.

During our Law and Order duty at Venus More, an intersection point under Siliguri PS, at about 15:10 hrs approx. 1000 to 1200 devotees were assembled there including public in general who were came to see the religious tableau and we helping the group of devotees to cross Venus More but in between this time, public was surprised by seeing that 45/50 numbers of unknown persons majority of them were youths were coming from Tikiapara Fly Over side by shouting and raising small sword in their hand which created an atmosphere of fear among the devotees. Accordingly, considering the fact and without wasting time I along with other officers and force immediately intervened and started to trace out the persons who created an atmosphere of fear among the devotees by shouting and raising small sword in their hand but large number of gathering made us impossible to trace out the persons and by taking advantage of crowd they escaped from the place.

After this incident everything became normal and the area became peaceful but only those 45 to 50 unknown persons who violated the order of the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court (WPA No. 7511 of 2024 & WPA No. 6515 of 2026) and temporarily created a noisy atmosphere in the area by shouting and running around by raising small sword in hand in the peaceful "Ram Navami" procession, and later fled away from the spot with their small swords, taking advantage of the crowd and after seeing Police action. Therefore after completion of duty, myself submitting this written complainant and also I pray before you to start a specific case under proper sections of law against those approx 45/50 Nos. of unknown persons and arrange for its investigation.
