Sub : FIR against a group of persons for carrying sharp cutting swords openly in procession.

Sir

With due respect and humble submission, I SI Laksang Bhutia of Pradhan Nagar P.S. would like to inform you that on 27.03.2026. I along with SI Gopal Chandra Mondal, ASI Tubai Roy and force were detailed for Ram Navami Procession duty at Hanuman Mandir Mallaguri P.S. Pradhan Nagar Dist Darjeeling vide Pradhan Nagar P.S GDE No. 1648 Dt:27.03.2026

Accordingly, I, SI Laksang Bhutia along with other officers and force took up our duty post at Hanuman Mandir Mallaguri P.S. Pradhan Nagar Dist Darjeeling at 10.45 hrs. On the occasion of Ram Navami, several organizations held processions on several roads within the jurisdiction of Pradhan Nagar Police Station. After taking up our duty posts on Hill Cart Road, in front of Hanuman Mandir, we started noticing huge number of people gathered there and took part in those processions where a group of 10/12 persons were seen carrying and brandishing swords having sharp edges openly. This is a violation of the solemn order of the H/High Court at Calcutta vide WPA 6515 of 2026 dated 20.03.26.

Such acts could pose a serious threat to public safety and may create panic among others within the rally where people from all ages were seen to take part. The public display of weapons in a crowded procession can potentially lead to untoward incidents, causing injury to others, disturb public peace, tranquillity and violate provisions of law relating to possession of arms. After noticing such display of weapons, I along with others officers and force tried to dissuade them from carrying and brandishing such swords in public and to identify them in vain as the crowd was huge in size and in motion with music.

Therefore, I request you to kindly look into the matter and take appropriate legal action against those 10/12 persons involved in carrying and brandishing sharp swords publicly under proper sections of laws.
