**Subject: F.I.R**

**Respected Sir,**

I, Ashok Kundu, son of Late Gopal Chandra Kundu, resident of Bidya Chakra Colony, Siliguri, Ward No. 44 of S.M.C., P.O. Sevoke Road, P.S. Bhaktinagar, District – Jalpaiguri, Pin – 734001, most respectfully beg to state that in the month of July, 2025, I purchased one truck (6 Chakka), namely Tata LPT 1613, bearing Registration No. WB-78 6114, having Date of Registration 15/06/2016, Engine No. 697TC56GUY422568 and Chassis No. MAT373344G3E32211, registered at Siliguri A.R.T.O, from **Md. Majgul**, son of Najibaddin Md., resident of Badlagach, Binnaguri, Fulbari Hat, District – Jalpaiguri, West Bengal. **(Contact no- 98324 12031).**

That at the time of negotiation and prior to the sale, the said Md. Majgul represented to me that the vehicle was in good and roadworthy condition and that there were no defects or liabilities attached to the said vehicle. Believing his statements to be true and acting upon his assurances, I agreed to purchase the said vehicle. However, after purchasing the vehicle, I gradually discovered that the accused had fraudulently and deliberately concealed the true and actual condition of the vehicle. Within a short period, I realized that the vehicle was in a very bad and damaged condition and that most of its parts were duplicate and not fit for proper use. That thereafter, I contacted the accused and informed him about the actual condition of the vehicle and requested him to take responsibility for the same, but he deliberately ignored my requests and refused to provide any assistance or remedy. Being left with no other alternative, I was compelled to repair the vehicle at my own cost, and I have spent approximately Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only) for replacing and repairing various parts of the vehicle in order to make it usable.

And additionally, at the time of negotiation and initial inspection, the said truck was shown to me in a particular condition, representing that it was equipped with its original tyres and all essential parts in proper and satisfactory condition. However, at the time of delivery, when i took possession and the vehicle came under his custody, and subsequent to the transfer of ownership in my name , I was shocked to discover that the Md. Majgul, had dishonestly and without any prior intimation or consent, replaced the original

tyres with inferior and worn-out ones and had also removed or altered several other important components of the truck. Upon noticing these material discrepancies and acts of misrepresentation, I immediately raised strong objections and demanded restoration of the vehicle to its original condition. Nevertheless, Md. Majgul, with deliberate intent and in a highly negligent and dismissive manner, refused to address or rectify the my grievances and carelessly neglected my legitimate demands,

That I state that despite suffering various losses and discrepancies in respect of the said vehicle, I tolerated the same in good faith and without immediate protest. However, in the month of February, 2026, when I personally approached the office of the A.R.T.O., Siliguri for the purpose of obtaining the fitness certificate of the said vehicle, I was informed by the concerned officials that an amount of approximately Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) was still outstanding against the said vehicle towards unpaid fines and penalties. Being taken aback by such information, I made further inquiries and upon verification of the official records, I came to learn that the previous owner, namely Md. Majgul, had fraudulently obtained a fitness certificate for the said vehicle from another State by deliberately suppressing and concealing the existence of such outstanding dues. I further state that the said Md. Majgul, with a dishonest intention to evade payment of penalties imposed by the Government of West Bengal, forged and fabricated Government documents and unlawfully procured a false fitness certificate from another State authority, thereby showing the vehicle as compliant. I say that such material facts, including the pendency of fines and the fraudulent procurement of fitness certification, were never disclosed to me at the time of sale or transfer of ownership of the said vehicle in my favour, which clearly establishes deliberate misrepresentation, forgery of government documents, fraud, and cheating on the part of the said Md. Majgul, causing me severe financial loss and harassment.

That due to such fraudulent acts, misrepresentation, and concealment of material facts by the accused, I have suffered substantial financial loss and I am now being wrongfully burdened with payment of the said outstanding amount of Rs. 50,000/-. It is further submitted that all the negotiations and dealings relating to the said vehicle were conducted near Shanti Nursing Home, Ward No. 10 of S.M.C., P.O. and P.S. Siliguri, District – Darjeeling, which falls under your jurisdiction.

That it is also pertinent to mention that the son of the accused, namely **Mohammad Siraj**, was actively involved in the entire transaction and had full

knowledge of the fraudulent acts committed by his father, and thus both of them have acted in connivance with each other to cheat me.

Therefore, I humbly request you to kindly treat this application as an F.I.R. and take necessary legal action against the accused persons Md. Majgul and Mohammad Siraj under appropriate provisions of law for cheating, fraud, and criminal conspiracy. I further request you to conduct a thorough investigation into the matter and take appropriate steps so that justice may be served.

I shall remain ever grateful for your kind cooperation.
