Sir,

In producing here with the seized articles viz:-

1.Total 04 (Four) No's Indane Domestic Gas cylinder fully Empty as Net weight 14.2 Kg.

Under proper seizure list. I ASI Chandi Roy of Enforcement Branch, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodge a written complaint against the owner namely Nayan Kumar Ghosh (43 years) S/O Lt Dhirendranath Ghosh of Indra Pally P.O- Kadamtala PS Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling owner of Homemade Sweet items factory at his own house located at Indra Pally P.O- Kadamtala PS Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling who has illegally procured the domestic Gas cylinder at his Sweet items factory for commercial purpose without any valid documents or license to the effect that today i.e. 30.03.2026 at about 16.30 hrs received an information from reliable source that above noted Sweet Factory situated at above mentioned address using the domestic Gas cylinder at his Sweet factory for preparing Sweets items for commercial purpose for his wrongful gain.

Hence I diarized the matter vide EB, SPC GDE No. 174 Dt. 30.03.2026 and informed the matter to ACP EB, SPC and as per his instruction myself along with ASI Arghya Das, C/1832 Nabab Sk all of EB, SPC left EB Office to proceed Indra Pally P.O- Kadamtala PS Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling to execute the information. This refers EB, SPC GDE No. 175 Dt. 30.03.2026 and C.C. No. 38/26 Dt.30.03.2026.

At about 18.15 hrs we reached at Homemade Sweet items factory at his own house located at Indra Pally P.O- Kadamtala PS Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling and contacted with source and being shown and identified by him, I along with officers and force conducted raid in the Sweet factory of Nayan Kumar Ghosh. During search found of Sweet factory making sweet items by using the domestic Indane Gas cylinder without any valid documents for commercial purpose, On demand he failed to produce any valid documents in support of using the Indane domestic gas cylinders in the Sweet factory of Nayan Kumar Ghosh for commercial purpose.

It is crystal clear that the said person namely Nayan Kumar Ghosh (43 years) S/O Lt Dhirendranath Ghosh of Indra Pally P.O- Kadamtala PS Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling is storing and using the Domestic gas cylinders in his homemade Sweet factory for his wrongful gain. As per local enquiry it came to light that the above noted person storing and using gas negligently with respect to fire or combustible matter, which may endanger human life or likely to cause hurt or injury to person at that locality area. Nayan Kumar Ghosh does not have any valid Documents regarding above seized articles. Thus the above noted accused person violated the provision of West Bengal Cooking Gas (License and Control) order 1985 and other Government Orders.

Accordingly I seized the above noted seized articles as per seizure list in presence of local witnesses namely 1) Srikanta Das S/O Lt. Chittaranjan Das Vill- Gosaipur Notun Para P.O- Gosaipur PS- Bagdogra Dist- Darjeeling 2) Sanjit Mahanta Das S/O Lt. Suresh Mahanta Das Vill- Bagdogra Bhujiyapani P.O- Bagdogra PS- Bagdogra Dist- Darjeeling.

Hence, I pray that a specific case may be recorded against the accused person namely Nayan Kumar Ghosh (43 years) S/O Lt Dhirendranath Ghosh of Indra Pally P.O- Kadamtala PS Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling U/S-287 BNS R/W Sec7(i)(a)(b)(c) of EC Act, 1955 . and other appropriate sections of law.
