**Sub: Complaint for Theft, Criminal Breach of Trust, Misappropriation of Funds and Removal of Official Records against Abhijit Kundu**

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, **PARASH DUBEY**, s/o Laxmi Narayan Dubey, **General Manager of AASTHA HEALTHCARE & RESEARCH CENTER PVT LTD**, situated at Medical College Road Opposite Bharat Petrol Pump NBMCH Kawakhari, Siliguri, West Bengal-734012, respectfully submit this complaint for your kind consideration.

That **Abhijit Kundu**, s/o Mritunjoy Kundu, resident of Workshop Colony, Shirampur, Bardhaman, West Bengal, Pin- 713321, was working in cash Counter at Aastha Hospital, Siliguri. He was entrusted with the responsibility of managing the counter and handling emergency funds collected from patients for medical treatment.

On and around the 1<sup>st</sup> week of February, he dishonestly misappropriated and absconded with an amount of **Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only)** collected from patients during medical emergencies. The said amount was entrusted to him in good faith in the course of his employment. When he was initially confronted regarding the shortage of funds, he admitted his misconduct and gave a written undertaking stating that he would not commit any such fraud in future and that he would **return the entire amount of Rs. 2,00,000/-** to the hospital from his salary.

However, despite such written assurance, he has failed to return the amount. Since last week, he has been deliberately **ignoring phone calls** and his mobile number is now switched off and **untraceable**. He is now absconding. Furthermore, he has illegally **taken away an important official register** containing detailed records of patients, treatment entries, and financial


transactions. Due to the removal of this register Patients are facing serious difficulties in receiving treatment, also the hospital administration is unable to verify patient records and there is obstruction in medical services. There is apprehension of tampering with or destruction of crucial evidence.

Shockingly, after stealing patient details and hospital records, the said person has started threatening the hospital authorities. He has demanded **Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only)** from the hospital and has clearly stated that if the amount is not paid to him, he will spread false rumours against the hospital, circulate confidential patient information, also damage and defame the reputation of the hospital and create panic and mistrust among patients and the public. Such acts amount to clear criminal intimidation and **extortion**. The said person is misusing stolen confidential medical data as a weapon to pressurize the hospital for **unlawful monetary gain**.

The acts attract offences punishable under relevant provisions of the law. Considering that the matter is serious in nature and requires immediate registration of FIR and prompt investigation. There is also strong apprehension that he may tamper with records. I therefore request you to kindly register an FIR against the said person and take immediate necessary legal action to trace, arrest him in accordance with law.


Kindly treat this matter as urgent.
