Subject: Complaint for registration of FIR against my husband Krishna Saha, S/O Lt. Utpal Kanti Saha, for physical assault, criminal intimidation.

Respected Sir,

I, Swapna Saha Paul, D/O Lt. Sudhar Chandra Paul, residing at Vill-Thiknikata, PO-Sushrutanagar, PS-Matigara District Darjeeling, the undersigned, most respectfully submit this complaint for your kind consideration and necessary legal action against my husband Krishna Saha, son of Late Utpal Kanta Saha, resident of Kalamjote, Sushrutanagar, Kauakhali, District Darjeeling, West Bengal - 734012.

That my marriage with the above-named accused person Krishna Saha was solemnized on 17.02.2012 according to Hindu rites and customs. After marriage I started residing at my matrimonial home with the intention of leading a peaceful married life.

At the time of my marriage, my poor mother arranged and paid Rs. 2,00,000 (Two Lakhs) in cash and gold ornaments worth approximately Rs. 5,00,000 (Five Lakhs) along with several household articles as per the demand of my husband.

However, after a few days of marriage, my husband started mentally and physically torturing me and repeatedly demanded more money from my parental family. As my mother was financially incapable of giving further money, my husband began abusing, insulting and assaulting me regularly.

After the death of my father-in-law and mother-in-law, the torture increased further. My husband started consuming alcohol regularly and used abusive language towards me. Whenever I protested against his behavior, he physically assaulted me.

Whenever I requested him to allow me to visit my parental house, he became violent, threatened me with a large Bamboo and on several occasions even pressed his foot on my neck in an attempt to choke and kill me.

During this unfortunate period of my married life, I became pregnant and gave birth to a male child on 16.05.2014, named Apoorva Saha, who is presently in my custody.

Due to the unbearable torture, I left my matrimonial home several times along with my child. However, my husband repeatedly came to my parental home and convinced me and

my family with promises that he would not torture me again. Believing his assurances, I returned to the matrimonial home for the sake of my marriage.

After some time he again started torturing me. He even forced me to take bank loans in my name and after receiving the loan money he disappeared for months, leaving me responsible to repay the loan from my small source of income.

Ultimately in the year 2019, I was compelled to leave my matrimonial home permanently with my child and started living in a rented house at Vill-Thiknikata, PO-Sushrutanagar, PS-Matigara, District Darjeeling.

Later, my husband somehow traced my rented house address and suddenly trespassed into my house, assaulted me in front of my son, and again demanded money. He threatened me with serious consequences if I refused.

I somehow managed to escape from that situation and took medical treatment on 03.01.2026 at North Bengal Medical College & Hospital, and the medical documents are enclosed herewith.

I am presently running a small piece hotel at Medical. After my marriage, I have been solely managing all my expenses, including my child's education and our daily living expenses. Everything was going well, and I was gradually building a good reputation through my business while trying to secure a better future for my child.

However, on 26.03.2026 at approximately 7:00 PM, I left my shop for a short while to go home and take some rest after work. At that time, I left my son, my mother, and my shop staff to look after the shop in my absence.

During this time, a group of people suddenly came to my shop. My mother noticed that my husband was also present with them. All of them forcefully entered my shop and started throwing and damaging items inside the shop. They picked up utensils and other objects and began assaulting my staff and my mother, who were present there.

Seeing his grandmother being beaten by the group of people, my child became extremely frightened and started crying. Instead of protecting his own child, my husband used abusive language and even slapped my son, causing him to get hurt and cry more.

In that distressed situation, my son somehow managed to call me. After receiving his call, I became extremely frightened knowing that my son and my mother were in danger. I immediately left my residence, where I am currently staying, and rushed towards my shop to rescue them.

However, before I could reach the shop, the group of people, including my husband, ran away from the location after creating chaos, damaging property, and assaulting the people present there.

At present, my minor son and I are living under extreme fear and mental distress due to the continuous threats and violence of my husband.

Therefore, I most humbly request you to kindly treat this complaint as an FIR and take appropriate legal action against the accused person under the relevant provisions of law and also take necessary steps for ensuring our safety.

I shall remain grateful for your prompt action.
