In producing herewith one accused person named Nishi Roy (48 years) S/O Lt Purna Roy of Roy Colony near Kalimandhir, ward no 42, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri under arrest along with following seized articles viz,

- 1) 11 (eleven) sealed bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 UP, Country Spirit, each Containing 600 ml, amounting of Rs 170/- each marked as Exhibit "A".
- 2) One sealed bottle of Himalayan Gold 60 UP, Country Spirit, each containing 600 ml, taken out from exhibit "A" for examination as Sample marked as Exhibit "A-1"

I PSI Sahanur Ramahan (8967883145) S/O Habibar Rahaman, of Bhaktinagar Police Station under Siliguri Police Commissionerate, wish to lodge a written complaint against an accused named Nishi Roy (48 years) S/O Lt Purna Roy of Roy Colony near Kalimandhir, ward no 42, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri. On 02.04.2026, at approximately 23:15 hours, I received information that an individual was storing and selling liquor at his shop, which is located at Roy Colony near Kalimandhir, ward no 42, under Bhaktinagar PS., without a valid license. Following this, Accordingly I noted the fact in GDE vide PS GDE no 103/26 dated 02.04.2026 for future reference and informed to the inspector In-Charge of the Police Station, and as per his directions, I, along with SI Uday Chakraborty, SI Youel Lepcha, ASI Dipak Karmakar, ASI Dhruba Misra and Constable Debraj Biswas (C/374), of Bhaktinagar PS, went to the location to verify the information.

We arrived at approximately 23:35 hours and, based on the identification provided by our source, found that illicit liquor was indeed being stored at his shop located at Roy Colony near Kalimandhir, ward no 42, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri. Consequently, we cordoned off the area and detained one individual, who identified himself as noted above. Upon further inspection, we discovered the illicit liquor at the shop. When asked, the individual failed to produce any valid license or documentation for possessing such items. Moreover, during interrogation, he admitted his Guilt of storing and selling the liquor without a license for his personal gain by illegal means, and it came to light that he has been running this business for the past six months for unlawful profit.

I seized the illegal liquor detailed above, preparing a proper seizure list in the presence of witnesses, and arrested the individual mentioned earlier after following all necessary procedures at the scene. The entire process of search and seizure occurred between 23.45 hours and 00:10 hours, and I informed the individual of the grounds for his arrest. The entire procedure was documented with audio and video recordings, as per protocol.

I, therefore pray before your good self that a specific case may kindly be initiated against Nishi Roy (48 years) S/O Lt Purna Roy of Roy Colony near Kalimandhir, ward no 42, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri under proper section of law and may arrange for its investigation.
