The Complainant most respectfully begs to state as follows: -

- 1. That the petitioner is one of the authorised signatory of Tirupati Vancom Private Limited, a private limited company, having its registered office at Arsuday, 4th Floor, 63/3B, Sarat Bose Road, Kolkata - 700025.
2. That the principal company is the absolute owner and in lawful, peaceful and continuous possession of land measuring 13.5 Kathas, appertaining to R.S. Plot No. 4/156 corresponding to L.R Plot No:- 16, R.S. Khatian No. 848/1, Mouza - Dabgram, Sheet No. 21, District - Jalpaiguri, by virtue of a registered Deed of Sale being Document No. 2830 of 2006 registered at A.D.S.R., Rajganj and the said land has also been duly recorded by the petitioner company in L.R Khatian No.165.
3. That for protection of the said land, boundary wall has been constructed and security personnel are engaged by the company.
4. That in the month of January 2026, the accused person Kajal Sarkar, along with his associates and hired men and goons, on several occasions attempted to criminally trespass, illegally enter and forcibly grab the company's land by using threats, intimidation and muscle power.

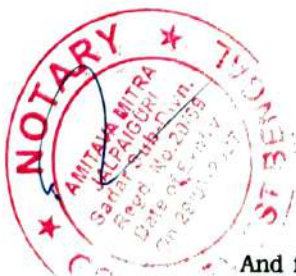

5. **That** the accused persons recently on 22.02.2026, **broke open and changed with the lock of the main entrance gate** of the said landed property and attempted to enter inside the premises and threatened the company's security guard Sri Bahadur with dire consequences, thereby committing offences of **criminal intimidation and mischief**.
6. **That** the peaceful possession of the company is under imminent threat and there is real apprehension of **forcible dispossession at any time**, which requires immediate police intervention.
7. **That** in order to give colour of legality to their criminal acts, the accused persons have **manufactured and circulated forged and fabricated deeds and documents** being document No. 1374 of 2017 registered at the office of ADSR at Jalpaiguri which have no legal sanctity and are being used to justify their illegal attempts over the company's land.
8. **That** the aforesaid acts disclose commission of cognizable offences because
9. **That** the petitioner approached the Officer-in-Charge, NJP Police Station on 22.02.2026 by submitting a written FIR dated **22.02.2026**, but the said police did not receive the complaint of the petitioner and thus the petitioner has submitted the complaint before the Commissioner, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, on 23.02.2026 and till date no action has been taken by the investigating agency, thus the Petitioner is compelled to come before your Ld. Court for justice
10. **That** the petitioner has no other efficacious remedy except to approach this Ld. Court **Under Section 175 (3) of BNSS, 2023** for appropriate directions to the police authorities.
11. **That** this application is made bona fide and for the ends of justice.

Under the above circumstances, it is prayed that your Honour would be graciously pleased to pass necessary order and to send this complaint U/Sec. 175 (3) of BNSS to the Officer -In-Charge, NJP Police Station with a direction to investigate the matter after treating this complaint as F.I.R. for the ends of justice.

And fir this act of kindness the complainant as in duty bound shall ever pray.
