Subject: Complaint regarding deliberate desecration of religious flags and outraging religious sentiments

Sir,

I, Krishna Tiwari, son of Laxman Tiwari, resident of Jorpakri, Bhalo Basa More, NJP, Siliguri, most respectfully submit as follows:

That I, along with other residents of my locality, had put up several religious flags of Lord Ram, Lord Hanuman, and other sacred symbols outside our houses, nearby shops, and within the locality as part of our Ram Navami celebration.

That on the morning of today, when I came out of my house, I found that several of the said flags were missing, while others were found lying on the street in a dirty and desecrated condition.

That being alarmed by the incident, I immediately checked the CCTV footage installed in front of my house and discovered that three persons, namely: Md. Tohid (S/o Md. Hakhik), Md. Joshim, and One other unidentified person, all residents of Jorpakri, Bhalo Basa More, had, at around 10:15 PM on the previous night, come to the spot and forcibly removed the said religious flags, threw them on the road, trampled upon them, and further urinated on them, thereby intentionally insulting and desecrating objects of our religious significance. The entire incident is recorded in my CCTV camera.

That their said acts are deliberate, malicious, and intended to outrage the religious feelings of the local Hindu residents and disturb communal harmony in the area.

That such conduct has created serious tension and unrest among the local Hindu inhabitants and may lead to further disturbance of public order if not addressed immediately.

Therefore, I humbly request you to Register an FIR against the accused persons under appropriate sections of law and take immediate legal action against them, and further ensure necessary measures to maintain peace and harmony in the locality.
