Sir,

I respectfully submit that I am producing herewith one (01) accused person, namely **Kartik Roy @ Bikash**, aged about 21 years, S/O Late Congress Roy, resident of Shantipara, near Shibmandir, P.S. NJP, District Jalpaiguri, who has been apprehended and arrested under a duly prepared memo of arrest, along with the following seized articles:

1. One (01) iron-made improvised small firearm (one-shooter), measuring approximately 10 inches in length, fitted with a wooden butt, body barrel, trigger, firing pin, and firing hammer, marked as **Exhibit-A**.
2. One (01) round of 7.62 mm live ammunition, marked as **Exhibit-B**.

In this connection, I beg to state that on 03.04.2026 at about 01:05 hours, I received a specific and credible source information to the effect that one person was loitering at Ambikanagar near the underpass within the jurisdiction of NJP Police Station, with the intention of selling illegal firearms to prospective customers. The said information was duly recorded in the General Diary vide GDE No. 105 dated 03.04.2026, and the matter was immediately reported to you. Acting upon your direction, I, along with SI Tanmoy Kundu, ASI Khagen Barman, Constable No. 453 Uttam Dey, Constable No. 1462 Sajan Tamang, VP/13 Jamirul Islam, and VP/08 Laxman Roy, proceeded to the aforesaid place in a government vehicle, equipped with necessary investigation kits, to verify the veracity of the information. Prior to conducting the operation, I secured the 02 (two) independent and respectable witnesses, namely: i) Md. Kalam, S/o Md. Moti, resident of Suryasen Colony, Block-F, P.S. NJP, District Jalpaiguri; ii) Bishnu Roy, S/o Late Binoy Roy, resident of Suryasen Colony, Block-B, P.S. NJP, District Jalpaiguri. After disclosing our identity and explaining the purpose of our visit, they consented to accompany the police party as independent witnesses.

Upon reaching the indicated spot, we noticed one individual standing in a suspicious manner. On perceiving the presence of the police party, the said individual attempted to flee from the spot; however, after a brief chase, he was apprehended. On being interrogated, the apprehended person disclosed his identity as stated above. Based on the prior source information, a search was conducted in the presence of the aforesaid witnesses, which led to the recovery of: One improvised firearm (Exhibit-A); and One round of 7.62 mm live ammunition (Exhibit-B); from his possession. On demand, the accused failed to produce any valid license or document authorizing the possession of the said arms and ammunition. Thus, he was found to be in illegal possession of firearms and ammunition, in contravention of the provisions of the Indian Arms Act, 1959.

Accordingly, the recovered articles were seized on the spot under a properly prepared seizure list, duly signed by the witnesses as well as the accused person. The seized articles were properly labeled and sealed in accordance with procedure. The accused was formally arrested, and the grounds of arrest were clearly explained to him. The whole process of search and seizure was made between 01.35-01.55 Hrs on 03/04/2026.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, I humbly request that a specific case be registered against the accused person, namely Kartik Roy @ Bikash, under the relevant provisions of the Indian Arms Act, 1959, and that necessary investigation be taken up in accordance with law. The seized articles have been duly deposited with the Malkhana Officer after observing all codal formalities.
