Subject: FIR regarding theft of 03 (three) nos. Isolating units from feeder pillar box of 160 KVA DTR located at Soubhagya Palace, Sevoke Road (near Sunny Tower), Dist:- Darjeeling under Power House Customer Care Centre

Sir,

I, Ranadip Mazumder, S/o Late Kalipada Mazumder, AE & Station Manager, Powerhouse CCC, WBSEDCL, duly empowered under the Indian Electricity Act, 2003 (amended in 2007), hereby report a theft incident that occurred on 29.03.2026 at Soubhagya Palace, Sevoke Road (near Sunny Tower), Dist:- Darjeeling, which warrants immediate attention and investigation.

On 29.03.2026 at approximately 3:50 PM, our LT maintenance team attended the above-mentioned DTR in response to a fuse call at Soubhagya Palace. However, the work could not be completed at that time due to the non-availability of spare parts for the feeder pillar, and the team left the site at around 4:25 PM.

Subsequently, the maintenance team revisited the same location at approximately 5:00 PM with the required spare parts for rectification work. Upon opening the feeder pillar box, it was observed that all isolating units from the incomer portion had been stolen. It was also noticed that the fiber enclosure was broken at the site.

From the above sequence of events, it is inferred that the theft of 03 (three) isolating units from the feeder pillar box took place between approximately 4:25 PM and 5:00 PM on the same day. Restoration of power supply was completed at around 5:25 PM.

The estimated financial loss incurred due to this theft is approximately Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty-Five Thousand only).

In light of the above, I kindly request you to register an FIR and initiate a thorough investigation into this matter at the earliest.
