indicated by the source, we approached one (01) person who was found standing in the said place. On noticing the police party approaching towards him, the said person attempted to flee from the spot; however, he was apprehended promptly and without incident. That, upon apprehension, we disclosed our identity and official capacity to the said person and informed him of the specific information received, and further intimated that he is required to be searched in connection therewith. On being questioned, the said person disclosed his identity as noted above and admitted that he is in unlawful possession of Brown Sugar, intended for sale to their prospective customers as per demand. That thereafter, a written notice was duly served upon the said person, informing them of their legal right to be searched in the presence of an Executive Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer. The said person, having understood the contents of the notice, expressed his willingness to be searched in the presence of either of the aforesaid authorities. That accordingly, the matter was immediately communicated to the Shri Ranjan Das, Inspector-in-Charge, NJP Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, who was detailed to act as Special Executive Magistrate for the day, was duly informed regarding the interception of the accused persons suspected to be in possession of Brown Sugar and was requested to kindly proceed to Tinbatti More Bus Stop under PS-NJP, District-Jalpaiguri to remain present and to supervise the search and seizure proceedings.

Accordingly, at around 22.15 hrs Shri Ranjan Das, Inspector-in-Charge, NJP Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, detailed for acting as Special Executive Magistrate, of SPC for the day arrived at the spot at Tinbatti More Bus Stop as Special Executive Magistrate, SPC. Then I offered the independent witnesses and the accused person to search our police party as per provision of law but they did not search the police party. After that in presence Shri Ranjan Das, I/C NJP PS detailed for acting as Special Executive Magistrate, of SPC for the day and 02 (two) independent witnesses, I searched the detained person who disclosed his identity as Sahajan Sarkar s/o Sarifuddin Sarkar, of Mohana, PO Mahipur, PS Kumarganj, District Dakshin Dinajpur following all formalities, keeping their decency and recovered the above noted 1) One white colour plastic packet wrapped with sellotape said to be brown sugar containing 600 grams approx mark as "Exhibit A" kept in one black colour backpack mark as "Exhibit B" along with one black and white motorwala 'RAZR' brand android mobile phone having IMEI No- 35529821116856/39 along with SIM having no- 8967872741, One blue colour redmi android mobile phone having IMEI No- 861721060910121/35 along with SIM Card having no-8158867477, Cash Rs 340/- (Three hundred and forty rupees only) in Indian currency marked as Exhibit "C", "D", "E": from the exclusive and conscious possession of above noted accused person. Further, on demand in presence of Shri Ranjan Das, I/C NJP PS detailed for acting as Special Executive Magistrate, of SPC for the day as well as independent witnesses the above noted detained person failed to produce any valid documents in support of possessing of Brown Sugar found from his possession.

Thereafter, I weighted recovered one white colour plastic packet wrapped with sellotape said to be brown sugar in presence of Shri Ranjan Das I/C NJP PS detailed for acting as Special Executive Magistrate, of SPC for the day and the independent witnesses with the weighing instrument and found total 600 (Six Hundred) grams of Brown Sugar in which were kept inside black colour backpack carrying by accused Sahajan Sarkar s/o Sarifuddin Sarkar, of Mohana, PO Mahipur, PS Kumarganj, District Dakshin Dinajpur and marked as Exhibit "A" and "B". Accordingly, I seized the above-noted articles from the exclusive possession of the above noted accused person at the spot i.e. Tinbatti More Bus Stop, under PS NJP, District - Jalpaiguri, as per the attached seizure list. The seizure and labeled was conducted in the presence of Shri Ranjan Das, I/C NJP PS, detailed to act as Special Executive Magistrate of SPC for the day, as well as the independent witnesses mentioned above. Subsequently, the entire seizure process took place between 22:25 hrs and 22:45 hrs on 07/04/2026.


During the course of further interrogation, the accused person hereinabove named, in the presence of Shri Ranjan Das, I/C, NJP Police Station, who was duly detailed to function as Special Executive Magistrate for the day, and in the presence of independent witnesses, voluntarily and without any coercion admitted that he had clandestinely procured the aforesaid contraband substance, namely Brown Sugar, from the Malda region with the intention of selling the same to selected customers at an enhanced price for wrongful gain through illegal means. The accused person further disclosed that he had been continuously engaged in such illegal procurement and sale of Brown Sugar for the past several years for the purpose of deriving unlawful gain. Thereafter, at about 23:01 hours, I placed the aforesaid accused person under arrest after duly complying with all statutory formalities, including informing him of the grounds of arrest, and thereafter issued the requisite Memo of Arrest in accordance with law.

In view of the facts and circumstances stated hereinabove, it is most respectfully prayed that yourself to register a case against the arrested accused person namely **Sahajan Sarkar (39 years), son of Sarifuddin Sarkar, resident of Village Mohana, Post Office Mahipur, Police Station Kumarganj, District Dakshin Dinajpur** under the appropriate provisions of law, and to cause a fair, impartial, and expeditious investigation into the matter in accordance with law.
