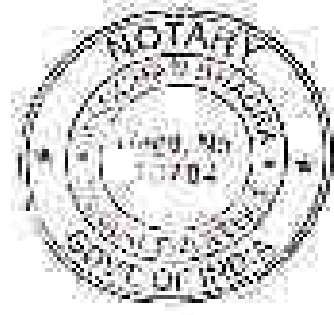

1. That the complainant is a person living and law-abiding citizen of India, and presently residing at the above stated address i.e., at C/o Md Al, P.O. Satellite Township, P.S. N.T.P. Dist. - Jalpaiguri, in the State of West Bengal.
2. That the complainant got married by type of marriage registration with the married St. No. 1 i.e., **RUPSHAD BEGAM** on 1st day of March, 2011 at Siliguri Marriage Registration Office and subsequently next year i.e., in the year of 2012 they performed their social marriage in the presence of family members, relatives, friends & well-



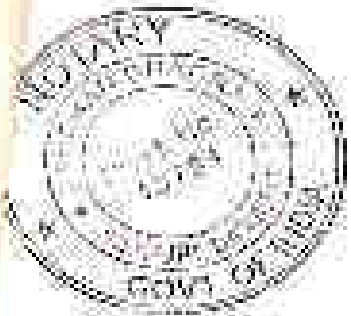

wishers of the both parties. It is to be noted that that complainant belonged from a very economical weaker section and his ancestral house is situated at Kalahari Gachh, Chopra, Das Para, Uttar Dinajpur and most of the members of his family are farmer by occupation and they still lived in the above noted address i.e., Kalahari Gachh, Chopra, Das Para, Uttar Dinajpur, but the complainant above noted somehow did his higher education and got Government job as a School teacher in Shaktiach Vidyapith (H.B.) at Siliguri, and at that time the complainant was a tenant and used to reside in the house of Sl. No. 2 above noted i.e., SAIDUL ISLAM (from 2007 to 2011) at Natun Para, Jalpai More, near 5th Mahananda Bridge, P.O. Siliguri Bazar, P.S. Siliguri, Dist. - Darjeeling. During the year 2010 the complainant was looking for a groom for his marriage and being heard about this fact the Sl. No. 2 and his wife i.e., Sl. No. 3 Above Dilara Begam came to the house of the complainant and gave him proposal to marry their elder daughter i.e., Sl. No. 1 (RUPSHAD BEGAM) but the complainant refused their proposal and because at that time Sl. No. 1 above noted was 17+ years old and she was also like a sister to the complainant and the complainant also disclaimed the same to the Sl. No. 2 & 3 but since then they started to torture upon the complainant by mentally and after few days Sl. No. 2 & 3 called the complainant in their room at 12:00 AM and told him that they have no male child & if the complainant will marry their elder daughter i.e., Sl. No. 1 then they would be happy to get a son like him & their daughter i.e., Sl. No. 1 will be in safe hands they also told to the complainant that coincidentally he is a school teacher by profession and his workplace is also nearby their house i.e., house of Sl. No. 2 & the relation would be more strengthen if the complainant will marry their elder daughter and along with these interactions with the complainant Sl. No. 2 & 3 also hold the hands of the complainant and insisted & cried for their elder daughter's (Sl. No. 1) marriage. Since the complainant was living alone in the Siliguri he became victim of their emotional torture and asked the Sl. No. 2 & 3 to ask their daughter, if she is agreed or not about the marry, consequences of that Sl. No. 2 & 3 told the complainant that their elder daughter has no objection about the marriage and consequently complainant & Sl. No. 1 became a couple after their marriage.

3. That thereafter complainant and his wife i.e., Sl. No. 1 started to living a happy conjugal life and were very careful towards each other and they started to living in a rented house at Shuola Para and they also travelled many places around India like Sundarban, Kolkata, Digha, and later they also visited many places like Delhi, Rajasthan, Darjeeling. Since the complainant is a teacher by profession he also encouraged he wife i.e., Sl. No. 1 to continue her study and subsequently she completed her B.A. degree in the year 2013. After completion of her graduation the complainant also encouraged her wife i.e., Sl. No. 1 to pursue her Masters Degree (M.A.) and engaged a house maid with the intention that her wife (Sl. No. 1) would get more time to study properly and in the year of 2015 her wife (Sl. No. 1) completed her M.A. degree in History. Thereafter the complainant further to pursue higher study enrolled her wife (Sl. No. 1) in D. Ed. Course at Sidhu Kanhu Birla University but unfortunately the said university found to be false one and complainant lost rupees 1.5 lac. After all that complainant supported his wife (Sl. No. 1) with mental and economical capability. Sl. No. 1 then in the year of 2022 January expressed her desire towards the complainant to pursue WBCS course and accordingly the complainant enrolled his wife (Sl. No. 1) in that course with the condition with the official of that institution that her wife (Sl. No. 1) will pursue or can continue the course until she got any Govt. Job & also paid the course fees Rs. 60,000/- approx. subsequently Sl. No. 1 expressed her will to pursue D. Ed. Ed. course and again the complainant without any objection or second thought enrolled her in J.B.P.T.T.I. and paid Rs. 1.5 lac as course fee.

It is also pertinent to mention that the complainant also help his wife's sister -

Notably i.e., Sl. No. 4 i.e., the younger daughter of the Sl. No. 2 & 3 to pursue her

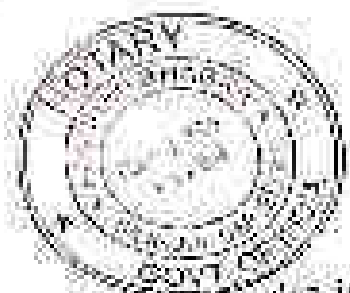

5. That thereafter the complainant alongwith his wife i.e., (Sl. No. 1) & their minor child shifted from their rental house to newly constructed house and the in-laws house of the complainant was adjacent to their newly constructed house. At that time the complainant was in huge financial trouble as he had to pay their newly constructed house EMI. Sl. No. 1 again started to prepare for her competitive exams and as his wife (Sl. No. 1) had to go to various places, the complainant also bought her a new watch in 2017 and paid the downpayment Rs. 30,000/- . It is pertinent to mention that complainant & his wife (Sl. No. 1) also got Rs. 10,000/- per month from the house that they have rented.

6. That thereafter in the year 2018 the complainant alongwith his wife (Sl. No. 1) goes to a marriage ceremony at Isampur and where the wife of the complainant made with her aunt's daughter's husband from where the Sl. No. 1 i.e., the wife of the complainant indulged in love relationship with her aunt's daughter's husband but at the initial stage the complainant did not notice such things subsequently one day the complainant called the complainant over the phone and disclosed all such things to the complainant that his wife (Sl. No. 1) is in a love relation with her daughter's husband. Consequently of that complainant in the absence of his wife searched he all logs and found the above facts were true, therefore the complainant politely asked his wife (Sl. No. 1) to not to indulge in such filthy matter but in response the Sl. No. 1 denied all these things and not allowed the complainant the phone with her again and then her aunt's daughter's husband, not stopping few days she (Sl. No. 1) again started to do such activity and during that time complainant's in-laws (Sl. No. 2 & 3) were also aware of such things i.e., their relations of complainant's wife with another person, and they were tried to convince their daughter to return from such things/activity, but she (Sl. No. 1) was not mind and own decision to do such stuff sometimes. Since then she stopped physical relation with the complainant and treated him with furious and bad manner. After this, the complainant also disclosed such matter to his in-laws (Sl. No. 2 & 3) but after that Sl. No. 1 confronted her parents i.e., (Sl. No. 2 & 3) and told that complainant is totally unfit to be made physical relation with her. On the other hand, the in-laws of the complainant also insulted him because of her wife's i.e., Sl. No. 1 such filthy relation with her daughter made her in divorce her husband with whom complainant's wife had that relation. Being fed up and depressed by his wife i.e., (Sl. No. 1) & for her such filthy relation and activities which complainant decided to disclosed all the things to his neighbors, his in-laws i.e., (Sl. No. 2 & 3) compelled him to hold his mouth with the assurance that they will manage all such things and everything will be okay. And complainant's in-laws (Sl. No. 2 & 3) also beaten up her with their own agency & filed activities and told the complainant that fracture her legs and hands to prevent her from doing all such things and they also told the complainant to keep away her name from her but sake of complainant's reputation he requested them i.e., (Sl. No. 2 & 3) to not to do such all things as this might be involve Police case and such other things but we all have family contract her. But all these efforts of the complainant go in vain, because elder uncle of the complainant's wife and one of his tenants were also aware about such facts. Even when the complainant was in police custody pertaining to a false case made by the in-laws (Sl. No. 2 & 3) wife of Sl. No. 1 again started to talk with that name's daughter's husband. Not only that apart from that

complainant's wife (Sl. No. 1) also indulged herself in that relation with use of... person of their locality and that person frequently visited complainant's house in the... absence and that also engaged with his wife over the telephonic conversation. After... that the complainant several times requested both of them i.e., his wife (Sl. No. 1) and... person of complainant's locality to refrain themselves from such things but they... the complainant not only they, being aware of such things complainant's... laws Sl. No. 2 & 3) also ignore the facts. That person also accompanied his wife (Sl. No. 1) and travel over and there, the person also gave the complainant's wife money... about all that complainant's wife (Sl. No. 1) indulged in an illicit relation with that... person of their locality and put pressure upon the complainant to give divorce.

That despite all such things complainant loved his wife i.e., (Sl. No. 1) and lived her... his wife and bought her gold ornaments worth 4 lacs in past two years. Thereafter... the complainant was falsely implicated in a criminal case being Bigamy Woman P.S.,... case No. 10 of 2024 dated 05/12/2024 U/s- 497- 498/13 of PC/20 Act, against which... complainant's another brother (Sl. No. 3 & 4) also filed a written complaint with the... P.S. for which a prosecution was started against the parents of the minor... case being Bigamy P.S. case No- 117/24, dated 10/02/2024 U/s-... 497/498/505/304/376/24 of IPC. After that due to the efforts of the lawyers... of the complaint was accepted and after 44 days, later 27, complainant came to know... that his wife (Sl. No. 3 & 4) along with complainant's wife (Sl. No. 1) tried to extort... Rs. 6 lacs from complainant's brothers & complainant himself, regarding the land &... financial expenditure, which complainant does not, complainant & his brothers belong from... very poor family and complainant's brother has also not into economically weaker... section, but for the sake of complainant's wellbeing they gave Rs. 3.7 lacs in each in... the hands of complainant's wife (Sl. No. 1) and her parents (Sl. No. 2 & 3) by... being cash hand in those try to dated 19/02/2024, 18/02/2024 & 21/02/2024... and complainant's wife transferred Rs. 50,000/- from his complainant's account... through (Spay and Swyft) when he was in judicial custody without the consent of... him. But total extorted amount was 6.03 lacs & after released from the custody complainant... wife of the complainant and her parents (Sl. No. 2 & 3) laughed up a large... extorted conspiracy & implicated him with a false statement in the presence of his... brother and brother's and forced the complainant to go to his home town with them... (Sl. No. 3 & 4) threatened him and drove him from his own house in the year 2024. On... day of April and drive them the complainant to house and started to live in Das... Para was home town of the complainant and he used to travel 140 KM on daily basis... to Palakurki, the house of his wife.

That at present complainant's wife (Sl. No. 1) along with her parents i.e., (Sl. No. 2 & 3) threatened the complainant to give the portion of the complainant's... property that was gifted to him by his father (Sl. No. 2 & 3) & the complainant... is the co-owner along with his wife (Sl. No. 1) in that property and they threatened... the complainant that not only to pay 15% & 10% loan payments by any means... After release from the judicial custody complainant's wife (Sl. No. 1) and alongwith... her parents (Sl. No. 2 & 3) water in Sl. No-4 demanded Rs. 140,000/- because... they told the complainant that their total court expenses were Rs. 6 Lak, then the... complainant took away from 100 of Rs. 2 Lak and Rs. 1 Lak transferred with the... account of his wife's bank Bansa Parvati (Sl. No-4) of 22/04/2021 and Rs. 20,000/-... with the account of his wife on 26/04/2024 & Rs. 20,000 transferred to the wife of... the complainant on 10/05/2024, Rs. 5,000/- transferred to her in 05/03/2024, Rs... 3,000/- transferred by the complainant with the A/c of Sl. No. 3 on 07/11/2023 &... presently the complainant came to know that the total court expenses were Rs... 6 Lak & the amount after deduction of Rs. 60,000/- from Rs. 7.80 Lak in... (Sl. No. 2 & 3) and (Sl. No-4).

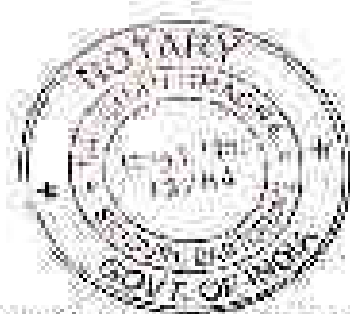

That Sl. No. 1 & 3 in the month of March 2023, complainant was being forced and pressurized by them to take a TOP UP loan because they needed the money for on the eve of Akilika celebration of minor child and also purchasing Gold ornaments of Serial No.1 and the marriage celebration of serial No.4 accordingly the complainant bow down his head before them and visited the Bank (PNB) FOR top up LOAN ALONG WITH SERIAL No.1 and informed the bank manager i.e. Sl. No.6 for the same as the conduct of complainant was good in respect of their house loan and being a prudent man he was paying the monthly EMI on time so they agreed for TOP UP loan and immediately complainant along with the serial No.1 on 20.02.2023 put signature on the application form of top up loan. The bank personnel also provided 1 (One) copy of agreement paper and also instructed the complainant & Sl. No. 1 to purchase a Non-Judicial Stamp and prepare the agreement and submit it to the bank. Accordingly complainant gave the agreement copy to serial no-1 and told her to purchase the stamp and Prepared the agreement and he will put his signature after completion of the agreement. And probably Sl. No. 1 also took complainant's signature on said agreement paper to submit it in the bank. The TOP UP loan was sanctioned on 25.03.23 and thereafter the said money was transferred into a New Over Draft account which was in the name of both i.e. complainant & his wife (Sl. No. 1) Rupshad Begum. Sl. No.1 has falsely accused the complainant stating that he had withdrawn an amount of Rs. 4,00,000/- from the OverDraft account for self use which is totally a false and baseless allegation. The actual fact of the case is that while Sl. No. 1 was in your custody from 04.02.2021 in connection with a false case BB/12/134 Case No. 8712, the above named person taking advantage of her absence had withdrawn various amount on various dates. Presently the complainant not to know that the agreement paper that was submitted by serial no-1 does not have his signature and his strong presumption is that his wife i.e. Sl. No. 1 with the conspiracy of serial no-1 to 4 forged complainant's signature and the serial No- 5 and 6 without verifying the authenticity of the signatures accepted their admission. It may be noted that on 11.01.2026 complainant made an application in the Branch/Regional Manager of Punjab National Bank of Sevon Road Deanna, Siliguri, Assam with documents in relation with OD account being No:31960009000000624 and according the bank on the same day provided the same. After getting these documents also inform the bank manager on 2.02.26 that the signature on the agreement paper and the serial no-1 did not have his signature. It may further be noted that serial No.1 closed the OD account because she along with serial No. 2 pressurized the complainant to purchase gold ornaments for the serial No.4 but complainant was not agreed. However, in transferred huge amount of money with the account of serial No. 4 in relation person in his family.

10. That finding no other alternative the complainant lodged a written complaint with the Inspector-in-Charge of Singuri P.S., Date - Docketing dated 11/02/2026 and that complaint was duly received by the duty officer of the said Police Station but an FIR was not registered for which the complainant again lodged complaint to the Commissioner of Police on 18/02/2026 but no fruitful result will come from the side of Police personnel.
11. That the accused persons described hatched up a deep rooted conspiracy against the complainant to cheat him with their craft and oblique motive for their illegal gain for share divorce and immovable property.
12. That the complainant apprehended that the aforesaid accused persons are very deep up in action and they may take desperate attempt to get divorce and obtain immovable property in the name of complainant & aforesaid Sl. No. 1 (or) will implead the complainant and use another false case.
13. That the complainant had moved the Police Station for the registration of FIR against the accused persons however the Police has not taken any action against the accused persons.

And for that act of kindness, the complainant is in duty bound and ever pray.

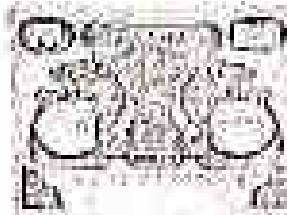
