Sir,

I am producing herewith the arrested person, namely Md. Sultan Ali (25 years), S/O Lt. Md. Sariful Islam of Netajinagar, near Masjid, Ward No. 42, P.O. Salugara, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, along with the seized articles.

- 1) One loaded iron-made improvised single-shot firearm having trigger, hammer, and firing pin, measuring approximately 10 inches including butt, body, and barrel, marked as Exhibit A.
- 2) One live ammunition, marked as Exhibit B.

Note: Exhibit A was kept concealed at the back side of his waist, and Exhibit B was kept in the left pocket of his trousers.

I, Sub-Inspector Youel Lepcha, son of Jai Tshering Lepcha, of Bhaktinagar Police Station, respectfully submit that on 04.04.2026 at approximately 23:45 hours, I received credible source information that one person was moving suspiciously with a firearm at Salugara Post Office Road, behind the football ground, Ward No. 42, under the jurisdiction of Bhaktinagar Police Station. The information further suggested that he was planning to commit a crime in the nearby area. Upon receipt of the information, I made a GD Entry vide Bhaktinagar P.S. GDE No. 225/26 dated 04.04.2026 and informed the I/C, P.S. As per his direction, I along with Sub-Inspector Uday Chakraborty, Assistant Sub-Inspector Dipak Karmakar, Assistant Sub-Inspector Dhurba Mishra, Probationer Sub-Inspector Sahanur Rahaman, and Constable No. 374 Debraj Biswas proceeded to the spot in a government vehicle. On the way, as per the order, I called K 37 Patrolling Van ASI Arjun Prasad Dhyani, along with his team to reach the spot and assist the raid.

At about 00:15 hours, we reached the said location where I met the source, who reconfirmed the information. Thereafter, we proceeded to the specified spot. Due to odd hours, no independent witnesses could be secured. On approaching the area, we noticed one person attempting to flee, who was apprehended tactfully. On questioning, he disclosed his identity as Md. Sultan Ali (25 years), S/O Lt. Md. Sariful Islam of Netajinagar, near Masjid, Ward No. 42, P.O. Salugara, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri. After apprehension, we disclosed our identities and the grounds of his detention. He admitted that he was present in the area with a firearm and ammunition, intending to commit a crime. Initially, he was offered an opportunity to search the police team, which he declined. Thereafter, his personal search was conducted in the presence of witnesses.

During the search, the aforesaid articles were recovered from his waist and pocket. On examination, the firearm was found to be loaded. I safely removed the live ammunition from the firearm and rendered it safe. On demand, he failed to produce any valid license or documents in support of possession of the firearm and ammunition. Accordingly, I seized and labeled the recovered articles as per procedure. A seizure list was prepared in the presence of witnesses, and their signatures were obtained thereon. The entire seizure process was conducted between 00:35 hours and 01:55 hours and documented through audio-visual means, I arrested him under Section 35 of the BNSS.

In light of the facts and circumstances mentioned above, I respectfully request that a specific case be initiated against Md Sultan Ali (25 years) S/O Lt Md Sariful Islam of Netajinagar, near Masjid, ward no 42, PO Salugara, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
