Subject: Complaint regarding violation of norms during Ram Navami
procession

Sir,

I ASI Amit Lama of Bagdogra PS, SPC beg to state that on 27.03.2026 on the occasion of Ram Navami, a procession/program was conducted by an unknown organizing committee. During the said program at about 11.05 hrs the participants were found using high-volume DJ sound systems, displaying swords, and carrying other prohibited instruments in public near Ayapa temple under Bagdogra Police Station.

It is further submitted that such activities were carried out in clear violation of the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court regarding maintenance of law and order, prohibition on use of DJs, and restriction on display or carrying of arms during religious processions.

The program acts not only contravened the lawful orders but also had the potential to disturb public peace and tranquillity in the area. The identity of the organising committee and involved persons could not be ascertained at the spot and hence they are being treated as unknown.

Therefore, it is requested that a case be registered against the unknown committee/persons involved for violation of the Hon'ble High Court's orders and necessary legal action may kindly be taken accordingly.
