In producing herewith the accused person named Pradip Jaiswal (58 yrs), s/o- Late Viku Jaiswal, resident of Panighata Road, Upper Bagdogra, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (not verified) under custody along with following seized articles under proper seizure list:

- (i) Fourteen (14) bottles of HIMALAYAN FATA FATI 70° UP India Made Liquor, each contains 300 ml @ Rs. 50/-; out of which 01 bottle is taken out as sample and marked as Exhibit-A.
- (ii) Two (02) bottles of COSMOS FIFTY 50° UP India Made Liquor, each contains 750 ml @ Rs. 270/-; out of which 01 bottle is taken out as sample and marked as Exhibit-B.
- (iii) One multicolour nylon bag.

I, ASI Shekhar Lama of Bagdogra PS, S.P.C, Dist- Darjeeling, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the arrested accused person named Pradip Jaiswal (58 yrs), s/o- Late Viku Jaiswal, resident of Panighata Road, Upper Bagdogra, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (not verified) to the effect that on 02.04.2026 at around 18:25 hrs I received reliable source information that one suspect will come at Singhijhora TE service road of AH-02 near Singhijhora more under Bagdogra PS with huge quantity of liquor in his possession with a view to sell the same illegally to his designed customer for his wrongful gain. Accordingly, I informed the matter to O/C Bagdogra PS and as per his direction I along with ASI Amit Lama, VP/02 Pradip Roy, CV/389 Janak Singh & CV/375 Jogesh Barman left for Singhijhora TE service road of AH-02 near Singhijhora more under Bagdogra PS, SPC by Govt. vehicle No. WB61A/0137 to work out the secret source information. This refers to Bagdogra PS GDE No. 90 dated 02.04.2026. Under these circumstances any search warrant or authorization cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidences as well as of the escape of the offender. At around 18:40 hrs we reached near Singhijhora more beside AH-02 and ambushed there keeping the vehicle away and had been waiting for source indication. After a while being indication & identification by source at around 20:48 hrs I managed to apprehend one suspect with the help of accompanying Police personnel and interrogated him. On interrogation, he revealed his identity as Pradip Jaiswal (58 yrs), s/o- Late Viku Jaiswal, resident of Panighata Road, Upper Bagdogra, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling. We disclosed our identity to him and the input we had. We searched for the independent witnesses to be present there as witness during the process of search, seizure, if any. One independent witness named Mukesh Ray, aged 29 years, s/o- Biren Roy, resident of Singhijhora T.E, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (Ph. No. 7586838764) was there to witness the process of search and seizure, if any. Then, we searched the suspect who had carried a loaded multicolour nylon bag on his possession. On searching the bag, fourteen (14) bottles of HIMALAYAN FATA FATI 70° UP India Made Liquor, each contains 300 ml @ Rs. 50/- and two (02) bottles of COSMOS FIFTY 50° UP India Made Liquor, each contains 750 ml @ Rs. 270/- were recovered from the said bag. On demand, the detainee failed to produce any valid document/license for possessing & carrying that liquor. He confessed that he has been possessing, carrying & dealing in liquor illegally since long time for his wrongful gain. His involvement is well transpired in this case. Accordingly, I seized that liquor (as noted above) including the nylon bag from his possession under proper seizure list in presence of independent

witness and other Police personnel. At last, I arrested the involved accused Pradip Jaiswal (as noted above) after observing all legal formalities and communicating him the ground of arrest in writing as he has committed a cognizable offence in presence of Police Officers for possessing, carrying & dealing in liquor illegally and issued memo of arrest in this regard. The process of search, seizure & arrest is made in between 20:48 hrs and 21:05 hrs on 02.04.2026 through audio-video electronic means using Govt. mobile App 'WB E-Shakshya' vides Evidence Certificate No. C-90-64632-20260402220519.

Therefore, I request that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the involved arrested accused person named Pradip Jaiswal (58 yrs), s/o- Late Viku Jaiswal, resident of Panighata Road, Upper Bagdogra, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (not verified) and arrange for its investigation.
