Respected Sir,

I, Oyajed Ali Shekh, S/o. Late Helal Uddin Sekh, R/o. Meghlal Roy Road, Haiderpara, Ward No. 39 of SMC area, P.O. Rabindra Sarani, P.S. Bhaktinagar, District Jalpaiguri (W.B.), PIN-734006 is the constituted attorney and caretaker for Ram Dasi Paul, Wife of Sri Krishna Chandra Paul, and Sushama Paul, Wife of Late Jagannath Paul, both resident of Meghlal Roy Road, Haiderpara, Ward No. 40 of Siliguri Municipal Corporation, Post Office Rabindra Sarani, Police Station Bhaktinagar, District Jalpaiguri (W.B.), PIN-734006. Ram Dasi Paul and Sushama Paul are the owners in possession of land measuring 3 kathas or 0.05 acres approx., situated at Eastern Bypass, behind Wonder Marble, P.S. Bhaktinagar, District Jalpaiguri. The land is bounded on all four sides by a boundary wall.

On behalf of the owners, I have engaged labourers for construction work on the said land, which is being supervised by one Md. Javed. On 12.04.2026, at around 10:00 A.M., Smt. Monika Kurmi (sister of Md. Javed) came to the said plot of land on her scooter to deliver food and water to her brother. As she was about to enter the premises, the accused Nepal Roy and Mandhan Saha along with their associates numbering around 10 to 12 persons, who are residents of the locality, wrongfully restrained her and blocked her path. The accused Nepal Roy snatched the keys of her scooter. Thereafter, the accused Nepal Roy and Mandhan Saha, with the intent to outrage her modesty, caught hold of Smt. Monika Kurmi by her hair and started dragging her. When she cried out for help, Nepal Roy and Mandhan Saha began to assault Monika Kurmi by hitting her with blows, causing her physical pain and injury.

Upon hearing the commotion, Md. Javed rushed out from the construction site and managed to rescue Smt. Monika Kurmi from the clutches of the accused Nepal Roy and Mandhan Saha. The accused Nepal Roy and Mandhan Saha then criminally intimidated Md. Javed, threatening him with dire consequences and ordering him to immediately vacate the land with his workers and never return. Shortly thereafter, the accused Mandhan Saha, in furtherance of his criminal design, brought a JCB machine and used it to demolish and break the front gate of the property. After breaking the gate, the accused Mandhan Saha, along with 10 to 12 other men armed with iron rods and sticks, unlawfully entered onto the land. They threatened the labourers engaged in the construction work and forcibly drove them away from the site. Mandan Saha thereafter with the help of his associates carried away the construction material, 11 bags of cement and iron rods from the land.


Md. Javed immediately telephoned me and informed me of the incident, requesting my urgent presence. I rushed to the spot without delay.

Upon my arrival, the accused Nepal Roy and Mandhan Saha confronted me and falsely claimed that the land belonged to one Neelam Saria, and warned me not to enter the property.

I sought the help of other respectable persons from the locality and requested them to intervene. Upon their intervention, the accused Nepal Roy and Mandhan Saha and their armed associates left the premises, but not before issuing further threats.

It is submitted that the accused Neelam Saria, in a pre-planned criminal conspiracy with Nepal Roy and Mandhan Saha, is attempting to grab the said land by using forged and fabricated documents. For the past several months, Mandhan Saha and Nepal Roy and their associates have been making continuous efforts to illegally dispossess the rightful owners, Smt. Ram Dasi Paul and Smt. Sushma Paul, from their property through force and intimidation.

Sir, I would kindly request you to look into the matter and initiate appropriate legal action against Nepal Roy and his associates.
