Subject: Complaint regarding attempted encroachment on private land of Siliguri Motels Private Limited and PWD Road Reserved land

Sir,

This is to bring to your kind notice that Siliguri Motels Private Limited, a company registered under The Companies Act, 1956, having its registered office at Jamyrta Niwas, Opp. Don Bosco School, Jyoti Nagar, Sevoke Road, Siliguri – 734001, District Jalpaiguri, P.O. Sevoke Road & P.S. Bhaktinagar, West Bengal, is the lawful owner of the below-scheduled property, having purchased the same through registered Deeds of Sale, since 1990.

There is a G +5 storied building on the said land since long. Today, i.e. on 17th April, 2026 at about 4.00 P.M., one Soumen Chakraborty, (son of not known), who used to run a shop named Borny Timber Traders, on the western side of the below scheduled land broke a portion of the wall, measuring 3 foot by 2.5 ft. from the inside of his shop with a view to damage and cause loss to the below scheduled land/ property on the western part.

The aforesaid Soumen Chakraborty, Debasish Singh, Sri Aarti Chowdhury, Sri Mukesh Gupta, Sri Utpal Ray, Sri Shambhu Sah, have no right, title, or interest on the said land and if his attempt of further damaging the western side of the wall is not immediately stopped then Siliguri Motels Private Limited will suffer irreparable loss and injury.

After intervention of the police the aforesaid Soumen Chakraborty and his men stopped for a while but, after an hour the other squatters viz. started threatening the staff and mistries of the company that they would teach them a lesson if any complaint is make to the police, and further threatened that they would not allow Siliguri Motels Private Limited to make any new construction.

Under the circumstances, I request you to take necessary action against the aforesaid person as per law.
