I, **Dr. Sanjib Sarkar**, son of Late Bimal Sarkar, presently working as **Facility Director of Neotia Getwel Multispecialty Hospital**, Siliguri, situated at Uttorayan Township, behind City Centre, Matigara, District Darjeeling, would like to bring to your notice the following facts and circumstances for necessary legal action.

At the outset, I wish to state that a patient namely **Mr. Ajay Kumar Singh**, son of Mr. Akhilendra Singh, aged about 40 years, resident of BG-18, Neela Apartments, Anandapur Village, Electronic City Phase-2, Bangalore, Karnataka – 560102, Phone No. 7204028143 / 8972154310, was admitted to **Neotia Getwel Multispecialty Hospital** on **01/04/2026** at around **4:15 AM**.

The patient was admitted with a **critical medical condition (chronic kidney disease)** and was treated under the supervision of **Dr. Ajit Kumar Singh**. The patient was allotted **IP No. UID 2611/3503**.

Being a responsible healthcare institution, we provided all necessary medical care, treatment, medicines, and allied services to the patient. After adequate treatment, the patient was **declared fit for discharge on 08/04/2026**, and the same was communicated to the patient's wife **Mrs. Jyoti Mishra**.

However, the patient's family members did not come to complete the discharge formalities on the said date. Our hospital authorities repeatedly contacted **Mrs. Jyoti Mishra** from **08/04/2026 onwards**, requesting her to clear the hospital dues and complete the discharge procedure. Despite repeated reminders, no response was received from the attendant. False commitments were also made to the hospital officials.

Finally, on **13/04/2026** at around **4:00 PM**, Mrs. Jyoti Mishra arrived at the hospital and **took the patient away from the hospital premises without clearing the outstanding dues** which amounts to **Rs. 2,90,036/- (Rupees Two Lakh Ninety Thousand Thirty-Six Only)**.
