Dear Sir,

It has been informed to the undersigned by Sri Om Thapa, Office Boy and Sri Surhid Kumar Bose, Account Assistant of our Association that when they were checking the Employees' Quarters as a regular routine check up at about 11.00 AM today, 13.04.2026, they had noticed that almost all the windows of the Quarters of the Secretary (now vacant) and the Assistant Secretary (now vacant) had been stolen and almost all the window grills of those Quarters either have been stolen or damaged. All the Ceiling Fans (5 numbers)/Wall Hanging Fans (6 numbers), Electrical Bulbs, Switch Board and Electrical Wiring were stolen from the above mentioned Quarters during the darkness of night.

Further, the premises of our Association have become very unsafe for the Employees who are staying in the Association's Quarters allotted to them, because during the darkness of night some unknown miscreants (from different age groups, most of them are youths) have been regularly entering into the premises of our Association, by crossing over the Boundary Wall of our premises where the Employees' Quarters are situated (behind three sides of our Boundary Walls, there are residential areas and in the front side, the main road is situated). Those anti-social rank outsiders have been doing all sorts of illegal/immoral activities, consuming alcohol/drugs, throwing the empty bottles, thus polluting the social environment to a large extent. Sometimes, some unknown youths including minor boys and girls have also been entering into the premises of our Association during day time - and it seems from their appearance/gesture that they are Drug Addict.

In view of the circumstances as narrated above, we would request your goodself that realizing our helplessness, please look into the matter and do the needful to stop such illegal/anti-social activities in order to maintain Law & Order situation, to provide safety and security of our Employees, nab the miscreants and recover our stolen properties from them to prevent any further stealing of our valuable properties and also to save the environment for the overall interest of all concerned,.
