Subject: Complaint for offences of cheating, personation as public servants, and criminal breach of trust resulting in theft of gold jewellery

Respected Sir,

I, Smt Pushpa Devi Agarwal aged about 71 years, wife of Sri Om Prakash Agarwal, residing at Khalpara, Agrasen Road, Ward No. 9, Siliguri-734005 do hereby most respectfully submit this complaint for initiation of criminal proceedings against unknown persons who have committed serious cognizable offences against me.

The series of incident followed as under:

1. That on 24-04-2026, at about 12:30 pm approx., I was present at a place which is 200 mtr (i.e opposite to Baba Hosiery) away from my residence. I was coming from Sabji Market Khalpara in Rickshaw towards my residence.
2. That at the said time and place, 2 (Male) unknown individuals approached me. The said persons were dressed in plain clothes but represented themselves to be police officials, thereby creating a false impression of authority.  
That the said persons, in a deceitful and premeditated manner, informed me that today morning an incident of theft has already occurred in the same area at 6am. And therefore as a matter of precaution, they have suggested me or mentally forced me to remove all the jewellery.
4. That by such false representation and misuse of authority, the accused persons induced fear and compelled me to hand over my gold jewellery to them for alleged "checking" and "safe custody".
5. That acting under such inducement, coercion, and in bona fide belief of their representation as police personnel, I handed over the following gold jewellery items:
  - Item 1: 2 Gold Bangles
  - Item 2: 1 Gold Chain
  - Item 3: 2 Gold Rings
6. That thereafter, after approximately 2-3 minutes, the accused persons returned a paper-wrapped packet, stating that the jewellery had been checked and returned, and immediately left the spot in haste advising me to keep the jewellery safely and open only after reaching home.
7. That upon opening the said packet shortly thereafter, I was shocked to discover that the gold items were duplicate jewellery, and my original gold ornaments had been dishonestly misappropriated and replaced.

10. That I am an elderly lady and was specifically targeted due to my vulnerability. The incident has caused me substantial financial loss, mental trauma, and breach of personal security.
11. In view of the above facts and circumstances, I most respectfully pray that your good office may be pleased to:

- Register an FIR
- Conduct a prompt and thorough investigation into the matter.
- Identify, trace, and apprehend the accused persons at the earliest.
- Take necessary steps for recovery of my stolen gold jewellery;

I undertake to fully cooperate with the investigation and shall provide any further information, clarification, or identification assistance as may be required by the investigating authorities.
