Subject: Application for registering a First Information Report (FIR) regarding a theft and burglary at my residence.

Sir/Madam,

Respectfully, I, Pradip Kumar Dubey, a resident of Samanagar Bartala, wish to bring to your attention, through this letter, a major incident of theft that occurred at my home.

The details of the incident are as follows:

On April 19, 2026, I, along with my entire family, traveled to Kamakhya (Assam) to perform Puja (worship). No one was present at the house, and the main entrance was locked. Upon our return on April 21, 2026, we observed that the lock on the main gate of the house remained intact; however, upon entering and conducting an inspection, we discovered that thieves had broken the lock on the terrace gate to gain entry into the house. Upon entering the interior, we found that the locks on the rooms and cupboards had been forcibly broken, and all our belongings were scattered across the floor.

Upon verification, it was discovered that approximately Rs. 50,000 to Rs. 60,000 in cash, which had been kept in the cupboard, is missing.

Furthermore, the family's gold and silver jewelry—weighing between 50 to 60 grams—has also been stolen.

This incident has caused immense financial and mental distress to our family. I humbly request you to take this matter with the utmost seriousness, register an FIR immediately, conduct an inspection of the crime scene, and kindly take steps to apprehend the culprits so that our stolen belongings may be recovered.

I am ready to extend every possible cooperation to the police administration during the investigation.
