**Subject: Complaint against my husband and his family members**

Respected Sir,

I, Aarti Kumari, wife of Rakesh Prasad, presently residing at Vill& P O :  
Chowpukuria, Kestopur, Bagdogra, Dist: Darjeeling, Pin: 734014  
most respectfully submit as follows:

1. I was in a relationship with my husband **Mr. Rakesh Prasad**, since 29 November 2008. With the consent and approval of both our families, we solemnised our court marriage on **11.06.2022** and the same was registered under Special Marriage Act, 1954, and thereafter had a social marriage on **01.02.2023** according to Hindu rites and customs.
2. That after the marriage I resided with him and his family at my matrimonial home situated Behind Pratulla Apartment, Subrata Sanga, Deshbandhu Para, Siliguri, Dist: Darjeeling, PIN: 734004. My husband is a government employee working with **Indian Railways**.
3. That prior to marriage and thereafter, my husband and his family, particularly my mother-in-law **Mrs. Renu Prasad**, demanded dowry and taunted my mother for not providing sufficient dowry, she threatened that the marriage(baraat) would not take place unless further demands were met. They specifically asked for a gold chain for the groom, stating that it should be weighty; accordingly, a gold chain of approximately 20 grams was purchased and given. They also insisted that my family bear certain expenses from their side of the marriage. While it was not possible for us to take care of all such expenses, my family did cover the full cost of videography and photography, as well as the shehnai arrangements. That I had also given money to my husband prior to the marriage amounting to approximately Rs. 2 lakhs which also includes the expenses incurred by me for his shopping for the marriage. I have enclosed the said bill with the complaint itself. That even after marriage my mother-in-law repeatedly harassed, humiliated and abused me and my parents verbally and mentally assaulted me for not bringing enough

dowry as demanded and blamed me for the family's financial problems which caused me severe mental distress, anxiety, panic attack, inability to perform daily task and social withdrawal. That even after such incidents of mental assault I resided with them out of love and affection and with the hope that someday things will get better.

4. That during the time when I resided with my in-laws my sister-in-law **Miss. Ritu Prasad** unmarried and residing at my matrimonial home has also actively participated in the harassment, humiliation, verbal abuse along with my mother-in-law and encouraged my mother-in-law for the same. My sister-in-law did not contribute to any of the household responsibilities and instead treated me like a servant of the house to serve them and her friends even when I was sick, physically unwell and mentally distressed. Both my mother-in-law and sister-in-law also pressurized me to leave my job and stay at home to serve the family due to this daily harassment and taunts by both mother-in-law and sister-in-law caused me severe mental agony.
5. That from early in the marriage my husband and my mother-in-law humiliated me for not having a child, making demeaning remarks about my health, taunting me for not conceiving and depriving me of basic food and also taunting me as "infertile" and also with harsh words like "why don't you die then only my son can get married again" "You are unlucky ever since you came, this house has been ruined, because of your arrival, our life has been destroyed".
6. Despite being aware that there was very limited physical relationship between me and my husband, due to his daily drinking habit and coming home drunk, she continued to blame and humiliate me for not conceiving. We had also consulted doctors for medical evaluation however, treatment could not be continued due to financial constraints. Her conduct caused me severe emotional and mental distress. During medical consultation, a doctor had advised certain tests, including a sperm analysis of my husband. As per the report, he was diagnosed with **Teratozoospermia**, which is the main factor in difficulty in conceiving. Despite this, I was blamed and humiliated for not having a child.
7. That soon after the marriage, I observed concerning behaviour on the part of my husband, Mr. Rakesh Prasad. He frequently returned home late at night in an intoxicated state, avoided communication, and concealed his mobile phone and other electronic devices. Whenever I attempted to contact him, his

from friends, office colleagues, or his driver. I raised these concerns with my husband as well as his family members; however, they dismissed the same by stating that he was under stress. Despite my repeated concerns, no corrective steps were taken. This conduct caused me significant mental distress and formed part of the continuous mental cruelty I have suffered.

8. Then after which I discovered on **29 February 2024** that my husband had been in a pre-existing relationship with a woman named **Miss. Sima Biswas** residence of Kawakhali, Bidhanpally Siliguri, even before our marriage, this fact was deliberately concealed from me and my family. Even after marriage, he continued that illicit relationship despite my confrontations and his promises to end the illicit relationship and assurances by both my husband and Miss. Sima Biswas that they would end it. There after my husband also signed a written document dated 02.03.2024 in which he had promised and assured me that he would end the said illicit relationship and that he would stop any conversation with the said women and would never contact the said women in near future. I am enclosing the signed document herewith

9. That on 14.09.2025, I shifted along with my husband to a rented apartment situated at Bubai Basa near Hara Parbati Flower Decorator, Ward 33, Meghnath Sarani Road, Lake Town, Babupara, Siliguri - 734007, due to disputes between my husband and his family members. I shifted to the said apartment on the basis of assurances and promises made by my husband that he had ended his illicit relationship with Miss Sima and that our marital relationship would improve. Relying upon these assurances and with the intention to continue the marriage in good faith, I moved with him to the rented accommodation. However, shortly thereafter, my husband again started returning late at night in an intoxicated condition, and when questioned, he reacted aggressively and physically assaulted me. I later discovered that he had continued his relationship with Miss Sima despite the assurances given to me, which caused me severe mental distress, humiliation, and breach of trust.

10. That on multiple occasions my husband physically assaulted me while we stayed at the matrimonial home. He once forcibly threw me out of the house and on another occasion seized me by the hair and dragged me back inside while I was attempting to leave, in the presence of my in-laws. Rather than intervening, my in-laws remained silent and instead blamed and derided me

18. That the above-mentioned acts have caused me and my parents grave fear, serious mental harassment, physical pain, loss of dignity, financial loss and a sense of insecurity.

Therefore, I most humbly pray that you may be pleased to register an FIR against my husband and his family members and take immediate legal action against him and his family members for physical violence, mental harassment, dowry harassment, economic abuse, defamation, fraud and cheating and ensure recovery of the money given by me to my husband and also take immediate legal action against Miss Sima Biswas for mental agony, mental and physical trauma, threatening and harassment and that also ensure my safety and provide necessary protection. I am ready to cooperate with the investigation and provide all necessary evidence.

I shall remain ever grateful for your kind intervention.
