Subject: Complaint regarding domestic violence, molestation, harassment, and forceful eviction

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Pushpa Jaiswal, wife of Prakash Jaiswal, presently residing at Mea apartment, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor opposite gaushala main gate, Jamini ray road, Babu Para, ward 26, wish to lodge a formal complaint against my father-in-law Ram ratan prasad Jaiswal, mother-in-law Anuradha Jaiswal, and my husband Prakash Jaiswal, all residing at above address.

I respectfully submit that I have been subjected to continuous mental, physical, and emotional harassment by my in-laws and husband

"I state that I was married on 19<sup>th</sup> January 2008, and have two daughters out of my marriage and after my marriage I was regularly subjected to physical assault by my husband. However, due to pressure from my in-laws and concern for family reputation, I did not report these incidents earlier. My husband used to frequently consume alcohol and physically assault me during the night. As the situation gradually worsened and posed a serious threat to my life and safety, I was compelled to leave my matrimonial home on 30<sup>th</sup> December 2020 and take shelter at my father's house. At that time, my in-laws assured me that they would bring me back once the situation was under control, but no such effort was ever made by them.

There is an ongoing case pending before the Hon'ble Court, wherein an interim maintenance amount of ₹4,500 per month has been ordered in my favour. However, the same has not been paid to me till date, causing severe financial hardship to me and my two minor daughters.

Recently, my husband asked me to come and reside with him at my matrimonial home. Trusting his assurance, I went there. However, upon my arrival, my father-in-law started shouting and creating a hostile environment, due to which my husband fled from the house, leaving me and my children in a vulnerable condition. On 26/04/2026(Sunday) my father-in-law and husband forcefully pushed me out of my matrimonial home along with my 2 children aged 11 and 16 years respectively. We are left without shelter and support.

Further, I would like to state that:

My father-in-law has previously molested me. Due to social stigma and fear, I did not report the matter earlier.

He has now installed CCTV cameras in my personal room, severely violating my privacy and causing me mental distress.

My in-laws have forcefully pushed me out of the house along with my two minor daughters.

They have also made statements denying their relationship with my husband, despite him residing with them.

My mother-in-law is also mentally harassing me and attempting to extort money from me nearly 10 lakh rupees.

No proper maintenance or financial support is being provided to me or my children, and my children are growing up in extremely difficult circumstances.

I would also like to bring to your notice that I had previously filed an FIR against my husband as he had withheld my voter ID card (EPIC), preventing me from exercising my voting rights.

I am currently in a helpless situation with my two minor daughters and fear for our safety, dignity, and survival.

Therefore, I humbly request you to:

Register an FIR against the accused persons under relevant provisions of law.

Take strict legal action against them for harassment, molestation, domestic violence, and non-compliance with court orders.

Ensure immediate protection and safety for me and my children.

Help me secure my legal rights and maintenance.

I am ready to cooperate fully with the investigation and provide any further details as required.
