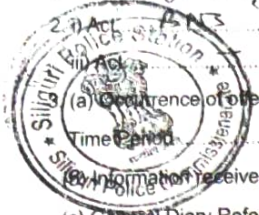

Subject: Registration of FIR in respect of Drunk, Rash and Negligent Driving Causing Grievous Hurt and Injuries, Attempt to Flee, and Offence Amounting to Culpable Homicide

Sir/Madam,

I, Rita Chhetri Pradhan, Wife of Shri Dhan Kumar Chhetri, resident of Buddha Mandir Road, Opposite Haiderpara Market Complex, Ward No. 40 under Siliguri Municipal Corporation, Post Office Haiderpara, Police Station Bhaktinagar, Pin Code 734006, State of West Bengal, do hereby solemnly lodge this complaint with deep anguish and grave concern.

That on 02/05/2026 at approximately 11:00 PM, at Sevoke Road, near Mint Bar and Restaurant, within your jurisdiction, a truck bearing registration number HR-55Y-5969, driven by one Sri Sunil Kumar (father's name not known), was being driven in a drunk, rash, reckless, and negligent manner, with complete disregard for human life and public safety.

At the said time and place, the driver, in a highly dangerous and uncontrolled manner, violently hit my husband, Shri Dhan Kumar Chhetri, Son of Late Balaram Chhetri. The impact was so severe that it resulted in catastrophic and life-altering injuries. My husband has sustained multiple grievous injuries, including fracture of the leg, multiple fractures extending from wrist to elbow, multiple rib fractures, and a serious head injury. The brutality of the accident has shattered his physical condition beyond recognition.

Due to the extreme severity of his injuries, he was immediately rushed to Neotia Getwel Multispecialty Hospital, Uttorayon Township, Matigara, Siliguri, where he is currently undergoing treatment and has already undergone major surgical procedures. As per the preliminary medical assessment, his condition is extremely critical and alarming. Early medical analysis suggests that the lower portion of his body is almost paralysed, leaving him potentially permanently disabled and fighting for his life.

The entire incident reflects not merely negligence but a gross, wilful, and dangerous act on the part of the accused driver, showing utter indifference to human life. His actions have destroyed a family and placed my husband in a condition where survival itself is uncertain.

Further, after committing such a heinous act, the accused attempted to flee from the scene in order to evade legal consequences. However, he was apprehended by vigilant members of the public near Panitanki More, Sevoke Road, Siliguri, which clearly indicates his guilty mind and intention to escape responsibility.

The act committed by the accused is not a mere accident but a grave and serious offence that amounts to culpable homicide, aggregating from the intention and knowledge of such rash and negligent driving in a drunken state causing grievous hurt and endangering life. The nature of injuries, the manner of driving, and the attempt to abscond clearly attract stringent provisions under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, and the Motor Vehicle's Act, 1988, including those relating to Culpable Homicide not amounting to murder, Causing grievous hurt, Act endangering life and personal safety of others, Dangerous driving, Driving at excessive speed, Driving by a drunken person, Duty of driver in Case of Accident and Injury to a person, and other relevant sections.

I am a distressed wife seeking justice for my husband, who is now lying in a hospital bed, struggling between life and death, possibly condemned to a life of permanent disability due to the reckless and inhuman act of the accused.

I therefore demand you to:

1. Register an FIR against the accused driver Sri Sunil Kumar and the owner of the offending vehicle No. HR-55Y-5969 under appropriate and stringent provisions of law, including drunk and drive and culpable homicide.

2. Conduct a thorough and impartial investigation into the matter.
3. Take immediate and strict legal action against all responsible persons to ensure justice.

I further of prompt action in this matter of extreme urgency and human suffering to meet the ends of justice.
