**Subject: Application for Registration of First Information Report  
(FIR)**

Respected Sir,

I, Payel Saha, wife of Hrituraj Dey, daughter of Uttam Kumar Saha, resident of Chayanpara, Ghogomali, Ward No. 37 under Siliguri Municipal Corporation, District Jalpaiguri, PIN - 734006, WestBengal, most respectfully state as follows:

1. That I solemnized my marriage with Hrituraj Dey on 11.06.2025 out of love and affection, and thereafter started residing with him at his residence situated at English Bazar, Women's College Road, Ujal Club Opposite Lane, Fela Master Lane, Dey Bari, District Malda, PIN - 732101.
2. That within six days of marriage, my husband revealed his true nature as a habitual alcoholic and substance abuser, frequently returning home in an intoxicated condition and subjecting me to filthy, abusive, and degrading language.
3. That he unlawfully demanded a sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs) from me, despite being aware of my inability to arrange such an amount, and continuously harassed me for the same.
4. That upon my protest and complaint to my in-laws, instead of any relief, I was subjected to escalating cruelty, harassment, and torture, rendering my life in the matrimonial home intolerable and undignified.
5. That my husband, along with his family members, subjected me to repeated physical assaults, severe mental cruelty, verbal abuse, and humiliation, thereby destroying the sanctity of the marital relationship.
6. That on multiple occasions, I was wrongfully confined inside a room, deprived of basic necessities such as food, clothing, and medical care, solely for failing to fulfil the unlawful dowry demand.
7. That during one particularly brutal and inhuman incident, when I cried for help, my husband and his family members mercilessly assaulted me with a leather

belt, causing serious injuries and extreme physical pain, and deliberately denied me medical treatment.

8. That my husband repeatedly forced himself upon me against my will and consent, even during my menstrual periods, amounting to continuous sexual violence and criminal intimidation.
9. That upon discovering my pregnancy of approximately one month and informing my husband, he, in collusion with his family members, forcibly terminated the pregnancy against my will, causing me grave physical and emotional trauma.
10. That being unable to endure such grave cruelty and life-threatening abuse, I returned to my parental home. Subsequently, my husband and my family, gave assurances of good conduct, and persuaded me to return. However after my return, he resumed the same pattern of cruelty and torture without any change.

Therefore, I humbly pray before this concerned authority to kindly accept this written complaint and immediately register this written complaint as an FIR and take appropriate legal action to ensure justice. Kindly treat this matter as an urgent and acknowledge receipt of this complaint.
