Sir,

In producing herewith two arrested accused persons including one lady accused person namely (1) Banu Begum-30yrs w/o Md Prabir of Totaramjote, near kathpool, PS Naxalbari, Dist Darjeeling (Not verified) and (2) Md Idrij Ali @ Manik @ Sahil -36yrs s/o Md Halim of Biswas colony, near Rail par, PS Matigara Dist Darjeeling (not verified) along with the following seized articles under seizure as per seizure list:

[i] One (01) plastic zipper packet containing with 401 grams of suspected to be brown sugar & marked as- Exhibit-A.

[ii] One Blue colour Oppo Mobile phone having IMEI No-863996056956696 & 863996056956688

[iii] One Ash colour mobile phone having IMEI No-866762078959879 & 866762078959861 with Sim no-8918460642 & 8637887376

(iv) One violate colour Oppo mobile phone

(v) 100 pieces of Indian currency of Rs-100/ in denomination with 100X100 = 10.000/

I, SI Srimanta Chatterjee s/o Lt Debi Prasad Chatterjee of Matigara PS under Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodged this written complaint against above mentioned accused persons to the effect that on 26.04.26 at about 14.10 hrs, I received a reliable source input that two persons including one lady have gathered with huge quantity of brown Sugar in their possession for delivering the same at Paribahannagar perking area for their wrongful gain. It is reasonably believe that the persons may escape from the scene if Police party did not reach the spot immediately. The matter was diarized in Matigara PS GDE vide No. 2422 dated 26.04.26 and subsequently, I informed the matter to the I/C Matigara PS,SPC in writing and being directed by him, At about 14.15 hrs myself along with ASI Bikash Roy, ASI Dipak Chhetri, C/523 Sanjit Kundu, L/C-1286 Anisha Chhetri and LHG/0110028 Uma Roy all of Matigara PS with investigation kit (envelope, white paper, sealing wax, gum, seal, Digital weighing machine (Certified by the weight and Metallurgy department, Laptop & Printer) etc. left for Paribahannagar perking area under Matigara PS by govt. hired vehicle to verify the veracity of the information vide Matigara PS GDE no. 2423 dated 26.04.26 and M.C.C No- 1664/26 Dated 26.04.26.

Under this circumstance any search warrant or authorization cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidence or facility for the escape of the offender.

Thereafter at 13.25 hrs we reached in front of Paribahannagar perking area and waiting there also I called two independent witnesses namely, (1) Pankaj Sahu-28yrs s/o Lt Shyam Sundar Sahu of Matigara Bazar, near Boro Masjid, PS Matigara Dist Darjeeling and (2) Md Rana-19yrs s/o Kalu Seikh of Paribahannagar parking near IT Park PS Matigara Dist Darjeeling disclosed our identity and informed them about the information in hand and requested them in writing to accompany us in the whole process during search and seizure, if any and they gave in writing about their approval to accompany Police during raid, search and seizure.

At about 14.25 hrs I also informed Videographer Sannath Chatterjee (ph-9064687) s/o Basul Chatterjee of Aravindopally, Gokhul road, ward no-22 PS Edgort Dist Darjeeling, ever telephone to remain present at the PO for videography during search and seizure if any.

At about 14.35 hrs Videographer Sannath Chatterjee reached at the spot with camera being identified by my source we detained the above noted two persons with the help of Lady Police personal at Paribahanagar parking, Tin seeded place. We disclosed our identity to police personnel. On being asked they disclosed their identity as noted above. On further examination the above alleged lady and genis person stated that they are possessing "Brown Sugar" with them. Being identified by source and the information in hand and stated for the she will be searched for the purpose by lady Police. She admitted that she had illegally possessed brown sugar in her possession for selling the same to her designed customers as per requirement for her wrongful gain. I also stated to the genis person that he will be searched for the purpose by Police. He admitted that he had illegally possessed brown sugar in their possession for selling the same to his designed customers as per requirement for his wrongful gain.

I then gave an option in writing whether they will willing to be searched in presence of an Executive Magistrate or Gazette Police Officer, on return they given written reply that they are willing to be searched in presence of Gazette Police Officer. Then at about 14.50 hrs informed over telephone to Shri Manojit Sarkar, Inspector In-Charge, Matigara Police Station to come in front of Paribahan Nagar Parking area and requested him to presence during search and seizure of the Brown Sugar.

Accordingly at 14.58 hrs Shri Manojit Sarkar, Inspector In-Charge, Matigara Police Station arrived at the spot as Gazette Police Officer and subsequently, under his supervision in presence of witnesses the process of search of the detained lady and another guy was conducted following all formalities by Lady Police personal and police personnel and recovered the above noted articles from the exclusive possession of above noted lady accused and genis person. Subsequently, being demanded in presence of Shri Manojit Sarkar, Inspector In-Charge, Matigara PS as Gazetted Police Officer the detained persons failed to produce any valid document in support of possessing of the brown sugar.

Thereafter, I weighed the recovered packet with the weighing instrument and found total 401 grams found to be Brown sugar and Two android mobile phone which was kept inside from the pocket of Idris Ali also found one mobile phone and cash Rs-10,000/- inside the pocket of lady accused Basu Begum. Then, I seized the above noted articles at the spot under proper seizure list duly signed by the independent witnesses and accused persons. I also labeled and sealed all the articles under the supervision of Shri Manojit Sarkar, Inspector In-Charge of Matigara PS and witnesses and the accused persons. The whole process of search & seizure has been audio & VDO graphed by videographer Sri Sannath Chatterjee. The whole process of seizure was made in between 15.10 hrs to 15.40 hrs.

Then, I arrested the above noted accused lady namely Basu Begum-30yrs w/o Md Faahir of Totaramjots, near khatipool, PS Nasalhart, Dist Darjeeling (Not verified) after observing all formalities and informing the ground of her arrest in written and issue necessary Memo of Arrest u/s 35 (1) of CrPc and another accused persons namely Md Idris Ali @ Manik @ Sahil -36yrs s/o Md Halim of Biswas colony, near Rail par, PS Matigara Dist Darjeeling (not verified). On interrogation they stated that the lady Basu Begum procure the seized Brown sugar from Nasalhart to hand over the same to Md Idris Ali @ Manik @ Sahil -36yrs s/o Md Halim of Biswas colony, near Rail par, PS Matigara Dist Darjeeling (not verified) for selling the same to his customers.

From the above noted facts and seizure of incriminating articles it is quite evident that the accused persons namely (1) Basu Begum-30yrs w/o Md Faahir of Totaramjots, near khatipool, PS Nasalhart, Dist Darjeeling (Not verified) and (2) Md Idris Ali @ Manik @ Sahil -36yrs s/o Md Halim of Biswas colony, near Rail par, PS Matigara Dist Darjeeling (not

verified) are involved in producing and selling of brown sugar illegally contravening the norms of NDPS Act.

Under the above circumstances, I pray to you that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the arrested accused persons namely (1) Basu Begum-30yrs w/o Md Faahir of Totaramjots, near khatipool, PS Nasalhart, Dist Darjeeling (Not verified) and (2) Md Idris Ali @ Manik @ Sahil -36yrs s/o Md Halim of Biswas colony, near Rail par, PS Matigara Dist Darjeeling (not verified) also arrange for its investigation.
