Respected Sir,

I Smt Puspa Rani Sarkar, aged about 70 years, residing  
at Nivedita Sarani, PO - Kadamtala, Dist - Darjeeling, PIN - 734014,  
respectfully submit this complaint against my Advocate Shri  
Subhasis Dasgupta, practicing at Calcutta High Court, for committing  
acts of cheating, criminal breach of trust and misappropriation  
of my money.

That I engaged the said Advocate for filing and conducting  
two cases viz. (1) Writ Petition & (2) Civil Suit. In this regard,  
upon his demand of Court Fee, I paid him in the following manner:

All these sum up to Rs. 2,48,000. Issue arose when I demanded  
e-receipts of the said Court Fee as since the beginning, he  
said he filed the cases online and paid the Court Fee  
through e-Courts Digital Payment System. He said he would  
provide me those receipts as those are legitimate demand of  
the petitioner.

The above transactions to his account were made through  
Netbanking of Online SBI, by my Son Shri Subhasis Sarkar on  
my instructions from his account, on my behalf to the Advocate.

That the said Advocate assured me that he would file the cases and complete all necessary formalities. However despite a lapse of more than 10 days, he has failed to provide me with -

- (1) Any Court fees e-receipt.
- (2) Any Proper Case Numbers.
- (3) Order sheets or any documentary proof of filing.

On repeated requests, he has avoided giving clear answers, and has not clearly said when he would make those documents available.

To know the truth, I engaged one lawyer and from the reliable sources I came to know that no such cases are filed in the High Court. He enquired in the filing section of the High Court, and surprisingly by the case Nos. that Dasgupta provided, no cases registered. Dasgupta said two cases are filed.

- (1) WPA/5610/2026 as. Pusparani Sarkar vs State of WB & Ors.
- (2) CSOS/567/2026 as. Pusparani Sarkar vs. Prafulla Sarkar.

Though the property in dispute is not in the territorial jurisdiction of Kolkata, how come my Advocate file a case in High Court's Original side was the question that struck me.

From reliable sources I came to know, that Dasgupta gave me manipulated and forged dates and dates of the cases and he never lodged any case as confirmed from the filing counter.

One instance, Dasgupta took an email id from my son and said that all official and necessary informations from the Registrar General would be made here. He assured those mails will come from the Registrar General. But the second mail has got date as 15.03.2026 instead of 14.03.2026. That brought doubt in my mind about being cheated and that the mails are fake too.

This clearly establishes that he had intentions to cheat from the very beginning, which squarely falls u/s 420. For ready reference and convenience, all mails are annexed here in this application.

Dasgupta didn't stop here, he repeatedly over phone calls with my son and whatsapp chats said that the matters are filed on the Bench of Justice Sougata Bhattacharyya and other Judge. Later he said that both the cases are set for analogous hearing on the Bench of Sougata Bhattacharyya. The mail sent to me also mentions the same, which means he is misusing the names of the Registrar, Justices and all dignitaries. On one instance, Dasgupta said that on the direction of Hon'ble Chief Justice, the case has been transferred to Calcutta High Court which was earlier filed on the Circuit Bench of Palpaiguri. All those are now found to be fake.

On repeated demands for the bills and receipts, Mr. Dasgupta gave a handwritten bill which indicates that payments are made and for appearance, again he demanded Rs. 28,000 which this time we didn't give.

On searching through internet we discovered that this Advocate was earlier arrested by the Police from the Bus Stand in front of a private school on Chetla Central Road for his direct involvement in a loot and attempt to murder case. This news is also annexed.

This clearly reports that he is a habitual offender and has past criminal activities.

He is having account in SBI, with Account No - 40156769827, which is a Regular Savings Bank A/c, and his PAN No is BKTPD1289 as his bank passbook mentions,

Thus as entrustment is proved by the way of bank transfer, and under the digital mode, also he failed to act as per his statements which are in whatsapp messages and on phone call record, that he clearly kept dodging the matter, so I request the Authority to take immediate action and take steps to return my money back to the source account i.e. of my son's account who paid him those sums on my instructions.

Hence I request you to file proper case and as per my conscience, this squarely falls up 406 and 420 alongwith other sec (if any).

The transactions done to Mr. Dasgupta is highlighted in the annexure and we have all other evidences like phone call record and whatsapp chat to establish the guilt.
