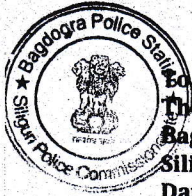

Sir,

With due respect, I am producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Shan Kujur (M/22 years Old) S/O Rahul Kujur R/O Hansquan, PS- Bagdogra, district- Darjeeling under arrest and the following articles under seizure. The ground of arrest duly been communicated with him.

1) One trolley attached with a blue Color Mahindra Tractor without number plate containing the resources of the riverbed

I, PSI-Gopal Roy presently attached with Bagdogra PS under your kind control beg to state that today i.e. on 08/05/2026 at 15:30 hrs I received a secret source information during my mobile van duty that one Tractor without number plate loaded with resources of the riverbed coming from Tarbandha and Proceeded towards MM Tarai for its clandestine disposal. Accordingly I informed the matter to the Officer-In-Charge of BDR PS and he instructed me to take laful action if required. As per kind direction and instruction of Officer-In-Charge, BDR PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate myself along with force C/900 Hrishikesh Barman and CV/133 Kartik Das all of BDR PS, SPC left for Kamalpur Tea Estate, PS- BDR, Dist.- Darjeeling to verify the veracity of the information. At about 16:00 hrs I along with force arrived at Kamalpur Tea Estate, PS- BDR, Dist.- Darjeeling and ambush in front of Kamalpur Tea Estate. At about 16:10 hrs we saw one Blue Color Tractor loaded with Sand without number plate coming from Tarbandha Side and Proceeded towards MM Tarai I signalled the driver of the said Tractor to stop the Tractor but ignoring our Signal he persistently prodded towards MM Tarai. After we chase the said Tractor we successfully intercept the said tractor at Kamalpur Tea Estate. On being asked the driver of the said Tractor disclosed his name and address as noted above. On demand he failed to produce any valid documents regarding the possession of sand loaded at Tractor as well as failed to produce any valid documents of the Tractor. On further interrogation he disclosed that he illegally taken the sand from Tarbandha River for clandestine disposal the same. That there is sufficient reason to believe that the above noted Driver have stolen those sand from Tarbandha River without any Legal Royalty/Paper as per rules, for selling clandestinely. Accordingly, I seized the said Tractor Without registration Number loaded resources with riverbed materials of sand after issuing proper Seizure list and arrest the accused person after issuing proper Memo of Arrest and observing all the guideline issued by the Apex Court. The whole process of search & seizure was made in between 16:16 hrs to 16:25 hrs on 08/05/2026.
