**Subject: Complaint Regarding Theft at Factory Premises**

Respected Sir,

I, Vikas Kumar Varma, son of Ramesh Varma, resident of Green Park, Scone Vatika, near Hans Villa Ashram, Post – Siliguri, Police Station – Bhaktinagar, District – Jalpaiguri, am a local resident of the aforesaid area.

I would like to state that I own a bottle manufacturing factory ( Name – S S ENTERPRISE ) situated at Bholanath Para, near Siliguri Club. On the night of 11/05/2026 at around 2:00 AM, my factory staff member, Surya Roy, closed the factory and left for his residence. Thereafter, today, on 12/05/2026 at approximately 7:00 AM, when my staff members arrived at the factory to resume work, they discovered that unknown persons had entered the factory premises by removing the exhaust fan from its fitting area and gained unlawful access inside the factory. The miscreants stole several valuable items from the premises.

The stolen articles include:

Approximately ₹80,000 worth of 6mm and 12mm electrical wires,

Aluminium and silver-made moulds worth approximately ₹3,50,000,

Additional machine parts and accessories worth around ₹60,000.

Upon receiving information from my staff, I immediately conducted a thorough search for the stolen items, but no trace of them could be found.

Therefore, having no other alternative, I seek your kind intervention in this matter.

I humbly request you to kindly look into the matter and take necessary legal action so that the stolen articles may be recovered and the persons responsible may be identified and punished accordingly.

For this act of kindness, I shall remain highly obliged.
