**SUBJECT: COMPLAINT AGAINST KULDEEP TIGGA, SIBAN
TIGGA, SULE TIGGA, GHUNJU TIGGA AND OTHERS.**

Respected Sir,

I, Sanjay Paul son of Nikhil Paul and a resident of Rabindrapally near Khaprail More, Matigara am writing this to file a formal complaint about several serious crimes that happened at my construction site.

I am currently running a construction project near Bagdogra Airport, which falls under your station's jurisdiction. I have built tin-shed quarters on the site to provide a safe place for my workers to stay and to store our construction materials and personal valuables.

On 11/05/2026 at around 5:30 PM, my Site Manager called to tell me that the people named above along with few others had illegally entered my Property and used force to break into and badly damage the tin-shed quarters. At that time some workers were working at the construction site and their personal belongings as well as some cash along with few construction equipments were kept inside the tin-shed quarters. The security guards on duty saw the group carrying sharp weapons and acting very violently. Their behaviour terrified the workers and staff. When the guards spotted them, they all ran away immediately but one person stayed for a short time but also fled as soon as my Site Manager arrived and identified him as Kuldeep Tigga.

Based on what my staff saw, the video evidences recorded by mobile phone and CCTV, I am holding Kuldeep, Siban, Sule and Ghunju Tigga responsible for this. I believe this was a planned/organized move to harass me and interfere with my project. This isn't the first time they have caused trouble, they have tried to extort money from me on several occasions before this.

I and my staffs inspected the vandalized tin-shed quarters and realized that several valuables and the amount of cash kept for future payments were missing. Here is the list of what was stolen:

1. Cash kept for Labourer Payments ₹ 18,000/-
2. Cash kept for Grill Work Payments ₹ 30,000/-
3. Digital Measuring Tape Machine 2 Units
5. Iron Cutter Machine 1 Unit
6. Electric cable- 3000 Ft.

These planned/organized actions of illegal entry, breaking into my Property, theft and threatening my as well as my staffs lives committed by Kuldeep Tigga and others are serious crimes under the law of the land.

I, therefore, request you to:

- Register my complaint as a formal FIR against Kuldeep Tigga and his associates immediately.
- Visit the site to investigate about the incident and the damages.
- Help me for getting back the stolen cash and other items as soon as possible.
- Arrest and interrogate the aforesaid accused persons so that myself, my staffs and workers can feel safe again.
- Provide police protection at the site so that these miscreants do not come back or cause more trouble.

The video evidences of the incident can be provided as required during further investigation. Thanking you in anticipation.
