I UMA DEVI AGRAWAL age - 76 yrs wife  
of Late Ram Deo Agrawal resident of Punjabi  
Pata, Shanti Niwas near Golden Apartment  
Shiv Mandir Road no-13. Respectfully  
want to state that I have two sons  
namely Vikash Agrawal and Rupesh Agrawal,  
My ~~elder~~ son, Rupesh Agrawal lives in  
North City Diamond 'A' Block and I presently  
staying with my younger son Vikash Agrawal  
at Shanti Niwas. I am seriously ill  
and suffering from kidney disease, nerve problems,  
Lungs problem. I am a dialysis patient and need  
regularly three times a week <sup>dialysis</sup> at Anandalone  
hospital. My monthly medical expense is around  
₹ 1 lakh including Dialysis, medicines, hospital  
visits and other treatments costs. When I ask  
my elder son for treatment he abuses me and  
uses slang languages. Rupesh does not give me any  
expense and as well as he does not take care of me.  
My younger son has no occupation or monthly income.  
because during the lifetime of my husband neither my  
husband nor my elder son allowed him to work  
or become financially independent. Therefore he is unable  
to bear my treatment and household expenses. On the  
other hand my elder son Rupesh Agrawal is a financially  
strong and wealthy person. After the death of my  
husband he took away all the gold, money and all the  
property documents without me and my younger son

knowledge by telling lie that my father is serious to send us to the hospital where my husband was admitted. He also stopped me from withdrawing my own money from Bank of India Sewoke Ad Branch OPPO. Guwahati, where I am the nominee. My elder son also says that in front of media that "My mother and my younger son, Vikash Agarwal has no right in my father's property"

So, I am humbly requesting you to kindly look into the matter and do the needful from your end.
