Sub - FIR regarding theft at my residence

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Bidyapati Chatterjee, residence of D02/03, Uttorayan Township, Matigara, Siliguri-734010 would like to report a theft that took place at my residence on 5th of May, 2026 during midnight. I was admitted in Chennai Apollo Hospital for my heart surgery on 5/5/2026 and my house remained locked, and unattended. Upon hearing the news it was discovered that:

- i) The kitchen window grill had been broken indicating forced entry.
- ii) The locks of cupboards had also been broken and tampered with.
- iii) Several valuable gold and silver ornaments weighing an approx of 40gms and liquid cash worth Rs 1,50,000/- were found missing.

I am an 82-year-old Doctor (medical practitioner), and due to my age and medical condition, this incident has caused me immense mental stress and hardship.

I request you to kindly register FIR regarding this matter and take necessary legal action at the earliest. I am ready to cooperate fully with the investigation and provide any further information required.
