Subject: Complaint for physical assault during participation
of a peaceful protest rally inside campus.

Respected Sir,

We the students of North Bengal Medical College, participated
in a peaceful protest today (13/5/26) at around 6:00 pm in North Bengal
Medical College & Hospital against corruption and the alleged paper
leak in NEET UG 2026.

During the protest rally in front of PGT Ladies
Hostel a group of alleged BJP-affiliated goons, who appeared
to be intoxicated, entered the campus area and started
creating disturbance. They used abusive and slang language
towards us and threatened protesting students. Then they
slapped and hit me then punched me randomly on my
face, they also assaulted Souvik Maity and Manisha Shaw
in the same manner. It is shocking that male goons from
outside assaulted a girl student inside the medical
college campus.

We feel unsafe after such an incident taking
place within the college premises.

I request you to kindly investigate the matter
seriously, identify the persons involved and take strict
legal action against those responsible for attacking and
intimidating students. We also ~~request~~ request proper security
arrangements inside the campus to prevent such incidents
in future.
