In producing herewith one arrested accused person, namely Biswajit Roy (25 yrs) s/o Lt. Giren Roy of Jaleshwari Bazaar, PO- Sahudangihat, , PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri, along with the following articles under proper seizure list: -

24 (Twenty-four) sealed bottles of "HIMALAYAN GOLD 60 UP PET India Made Liquor each bottle containing 600 ml, i.e. 600*24=14400 ml, having M.R.P. of Rs. 170/-, i.e. 170*24= 4080/-, blended and bottled by Himalayan Endeavour Pvt. Ltd and is marked as "Exhibit-A" out of which 01 (One) bottle taken as a sample and marked as "Exhibit-A-1".

I, ASI Dinesh Chandra Roy, s/o Lt. Madhu Roy of Ashighar OP, under Bhaktinagar Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above noted arrested accused person, Biswajit Roy, to the effect that today, 14/05/2026, at 22:25 hrs, I received a reliable source information regarding the unauthorized storage and sale of illicit liquor at a house in Jaleshwari Bazaar, under Bhaktinagar PS, Dist. Jalpaiguri. This information was duly recorded in the General Diary of Ashighar OP GDE No. 361, dated 14/05/2026 and shared with the Officer-in-Charge. Following his instructions, I led a team to Jaleshwari to verify the veracity of source information, arriving at approximately 23:15 hrs. After a brief period of surveillance awaiting the suspect's arrival, my source identified the accused person and accordingly we detained accused, Biswajit Roy. During interrogation, he disclosed his identity and admitted to storing and selling illicit liquor without a valid license for personal gain over the past few months. A search of the premises led to the recovery of the seized articles, for which he failed to produce any legal documentation or permits. Consequently, I seized and labeled the liquor under a proper seizure list between 23:30 hrs to 23:37 hrs, documented the process via videography, and arrested the accused after completing all necessary legal formalities on-site and informed him of his ground of arrest.

Under the above-noted fact and circumstances, I, therefore, pray before your good self that a specific case may kindly be initiated against the arrested accused person Biswajit Roy (25 yrs) s/o Lt. Roy of Jaleshwari Bazaar, PO- Sahudangihat, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri, under proper section of law and may arrange to cause its investigation for violation of rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act.
