Respected Sir,

SMT.SUPRIYA DUTTA, Wife of Sri Pranab Dey, presently residing at 1 No. Dabgram, Rajiv Gandhi Street, P.O. Rabindra Sarani, P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling, beg to inform you as follows :-

That on 22/01/2024 as per Hindu rights and custom I got married with Sri Pranab Dey, Son of Lt. Haripada Dey and it is right place to mention here that the marriage was arrange marriage giving 2 lakh cash and Gold Ornament (Shree Dhan) and many more house hold goods as dowry. After marriage both of us started to live together as husband and wife at my In-laws residence situated at the aforesaid address.

That since the inception of our marriage, my husband's behavior towards me was not good However, my mother-in-law namely Kalpana Dey, Wife of Late Haripada Dey, resident of the aforesaid address, sister-in-law namely Paromita Das and her husband namely Bubai Das, Son of Late Bajendra Das, resident of Dabgram, Siliguri always interfere the day-to-day affairs of my In-laws I house, causing me immense mental distress and started domestic violence.

That after seven days of marriage, my husband left for Uttar Pradesh for his service purpose, leaving me behind with my In-laws home for more than one year. During his absence my mother-in-law and my sister-in-law subjected me to physical and mental cruelty. They forced me to do all their household chores without providing for my basic needs, leading to deterioration in my mental and physical health. Despite their behavior, I tried my best to satisfy and adjust with my in-laws for the sake of my husband. In between he came back in Siliguri Mid of March for 7 days (2 days in Siliguri remaining days out of station for family tour in Assam.)

At the end of the August he resigned from his company back to Siliguri started living with me till 2025 mid of march. With in that six months I will be harassed by my husband (Pranab Dey), my mother in-law (Kalpana Dey), my sister in-law (Paromita Das) and brother In-law (Bubai Das) with slang language and mental torture.

Then mid of the march 2025 me and my husband shifted to Madhya Pradesh there we started living in a rented house. There my husband torture me and accused me along with his family blaming me as I am mentally retarded person. They also pressurized me for dowry. That my husband's brother-in-law namely Bubai Das, frequently visits our In laws home in a drunk state, using abusive languages against me, my husband and my family members. Despite my husband repeated requests to refrain such behavior, Bubai Das ignored him. The situation escalated on 19/05/2025, over phone to my mother the said Bubai Das became enraged and threatened to throw acid on my face and feed poison to me.

After returing from Madhya Predesh my husband inquired about acid attack with my in-laws after that she started screaming with abusive language to me and my mother and try to attack me physically on 12 of June 2025.

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So it is therefore prayed to take appropriate legal action against my above in-laws namely 1) Kalpana Dey (mother - in-laws), 2) Paromita Das (sister in-laws) and 3) Bubai Das (brother in-law) and 4) Pranab Dey (husband) who have conspired against me and subjected to injustice, at the possible assistance to ensure proper admiration of justice.
