**The Humble Petition under section 175 (3) BNSS of the above Noted
Petitioner cum complainant MOST RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH :-**

1. That the above noted Petitioner/ Complainant is the peace loving and law abiding citizen of India, but in the other hand the accused persons anti - social in nature.

2. That the brief fact of the case is that on 08.10.2025 when the complainant was going for Medicine Shop at Naresh More to buy medicine then the above noted accused person threw objectionable languages towards the complainant. When the complainant asked for the reason then the accused person abused the complainant with filthy languages and continuously assaulted him physically with kick, slap, blow and injured the complainant's leg with axe for which the complainant sustained bleeding injury. By hearing the screaming the complainant when the brother of the complainant and sister in law of the complainant rushed to the spot to rescue the complainant then the accused petitioner assaulted them with wooden stick and snatched 10 gram weight gold neckless from the neck of the sister in law of the complainant and threatened the complainant with dire consequences. Thereafter the complainant went to Siliguri District Hospital for treatment and two stitches were done in his leg by the doctor.


3. That on 09.10.2025 Petitioner lodged a written complainant in connection with the above noted incident before the O.C. Ashighar Out Post under Bhaktinagar P.S. Jalpaiguri. But unfortunately the concerned P.S did not take any steps against the above named accused persons. After that he informed the matter to the Commissionerate of Police Siliguri, Darjeeling on 14.10.2025 but no step is taken by him till today.

It is therefore prayed that your Honour would be graciously be pleased to direct the Inspector in charge, Bhaktinagar Police Station to cause investigation into the matter and treating this petition of complaint as F.I.R. under the provision of Section 175 (3)BNSS.


