With due regards, I, SMT. RITA GOSWAMI, Daughter of Late Nitai Goswami, Resident of Jeevan Rekha Apartment, Subhashpally Bazaar, P.O. &P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling, Pin: 734001, presently residing at Chinmoyee Apartment, P.O.- Rabindra Sarani and P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri, PIN- 734006, would like to lodge this written complaint before your good authority to the effect that SRI DIPANKAR KR. DEY, Son of Sri Dilip Dey, Resident of Suryanagar, 01 No. Dabgram, Pritilata Road, Ward No. 23 of S.M.C, P.O. Rabindra Sarani, P.S - Siliguri, presently residing at Binaymore, Pipeline, Kutimill Road, Godo House, P.O- Dabgram, P.S. Bhaktinagar , is my husband and our marriage was the outcome of our previous love and affairs and then, after taking consent of both the families, we have entered into the marital tie and subsequently, our marriage was solemnized on 11.05.2015 in accordance with Hindu Rites and Customs, after observing all formalities of a valid Hindu Marriage and prior to that on 03.06.2013, our married was registered as per the Special Marriage Act, 1954 before the Addl. Dist. Sub-registrar and Ex-Officio Marriage officer Smt. Tshering Doma Bhutia.

Sir soon after the solemnization of our marriage I went to my matrimonial house situated at Dabgram, Binaymore, Pipeline, Kutimill Road, Godo House, P.O- Dabgram, P.S. Bhaktinagar, and started to reside there with my husband and my in-laws. Sir, at the time of my marriage, cash amounting to Rs 40,000/- (rupees Forty thousand), various valuable articles and several Gold Ornaments were given by my family members to the family of my husband as per their demands and wishes, and all such gold ornaments and valuable articles are still in the custody of my husband but however, a few days after the marriage, I started to notice a drastic change in the behaviour of my husband and my in-laws, as they began expressing dissatisfaction with the items gifted by my family members and my relatives and it is further stated that, prior to the marriage, my husband had told me and my family that he was employed at the Bank of India, but soon after the marriage I came to know that he was in fact unemployed and not only that, my in-laws then continuously exerted immense pressure upon me to bring more money from my parental home and hand it over to my husband so that he could start and run a new business.

Sir, out of our lawful wedlock, one child was born to us, namely Master Diptangshu Dey, who is presently 6 years of age and I thought that initially after the birth of our son my husband's behaviour towards me would change but unfortunately, I was still subjected to continuous physical and mental torture by

unfortunately, I was still subjected to continuous physical and mental torture by my husband and his family members which was further supported by his family members. Furthermore, my in-laws and my husband, regularly used abusive, offensive, and derogatory language towards me and treated me with utmost disrespect. It is also pertinent to mention that my mother-in-law repeatedly taunted me by stating that she had never approved my marriage and had never wanted me marry her son but they were compelled to make her son marry me due to our previous love and affairs. Sir, moreover, my husband is a habitual drunkard and used to consume alcohol on a regular basis, after which he would return home and inflict severe mental and physical torture upon me and on one occasion in the year of 2016, my husband poured hot rice water (rice starch) on my body, particularly on my chest area, causing me burn injuries and when I protested against his such type of inhumane behaviour before my in-laws, they showed no remorse and instead abused me with filthy and offensive language. Sir, although I initially believed that with the passage of time my husband would realise his mistakes and rectify his such type of behaviour, unfortunately no such improvement ever occurred, and he continued to subject me to persistent physical, mental, and financial cruelty.

Sir, after passing of days of my marriage, I came to realize that my husband was completely unemployed and had a constant habit of creating pressure upon me to bring more money from my parental home and it is pertinent to mention that my mother treated my husband like her own son and had immense love and affection for him as her son-in-law and taking such undue advantage of such affection, my husband frequently exploited her and used her as a source of money making machine and further took huge amount of money from my mother on several occasions under various pretexts, sometimes he claimed that it was for securing a new job and at other times, my husband claimed that he wanted to start a new business and based on that lie, in the year 2017, taking advantage of my mother's trust and affection, my husband took an amount of Rs. 3,00,000/- in cash from my mother on the pretext of starting a new business and not only that, my husband also used to transfer considerable amount of money on many occasions from my mother's bank account to his own account by deceitfully obtaining the OTP from my mother for his wrongful and illegal gain and also on 07.08.19, an amount of Rs 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs) only was paid to my husband by my mother Smt. Ratna Goswami through Cheque being Cheque No. 825315 drawn on the State Bank of India, Court More Branch. Sir, my mother was employed with the Intelligence Bureau (I.B.) and she retired in the year 2023 and even after her retirement, my husband continued to take undue advantage of her by dishonestly taking away her pension money by making false representations and pleas and furthermore, in the year 2023, my husband came to my parental home and, with malafide intention, my husband stolen away my mother's Golden Bangle and sold the same for his wrongful and illegal gain and in this manner, my husband has exploited both me and my mother, fraudulently taking away and dishonestly

misappropriating large sums of money by deceitfully obtaining OTPs from my mother's phone and transferring substantial amounts from her bank account to his own bank account, and by repeatedly giving false plea and representations and taking money from my mother and in total, my husband has cheated and defrauded us of approximately Rs. 50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Lakhs).

Sir, not only did my husband extort money from my mother on several occasions, but he also took away my gold ornaments, which had been given to me at the time of my marriage, and kept them on mortgage before Muthoot Finance at Sevoke Road and by doing so, he obtained a substantial amount of money, which he subsequently spent on consuming alcohol and indulging in various other misdeeds. Moreover, my husband always remained busy on his phone, constantly talking to and chatting with several other women and when I came to know about this and confronted him, he abused me with filthy and offensive language and further inflicted immense mental and physical torture upon me and unable to bear the continuous physical and mental torture inflicted upon me by my husband, I was forced and compelled to leave my matrimonial house and take shelter in my parental house in the month of May, 2024 and since then, I have been residing with my aged mother and taking care of her. Sir, since after coming back to my parental home, on several occasions, I have attempted to contact my husband over the phone requesting him to continue his conjugal life with me but he flatly refused on every occasion, and rather abused me using filthy and derogatory language. Sir, it is also pertinent to mention that my in-laws, in active collusion with my husband, constantly threatened me with dire consequences and also threatened me of remarrying their son, i.e. my husband again with another woman and ruin my life permanently and Sir, recently, I came to know that my husband has again remarried with another lady namely Smt. Tapashi Karmakar, despite having full knowledge of the fact that I am still his legally married wife and in spite of this fact, he has unlawfully and illegally entered into another marriage.

I, therefore, request you to investigate into the matter and please take appropriate strong legal action against my husband namely Dipankar Dey, Father-In-Law namely Dilip Kr. Dey and Mother-In-Law namely Smt. Shefali Dey, as per the provision of law and obliged thereby.
