Sir,

In forwarding herewith two arrested accused persons, namely (i) Kanay Shil (30/M), son of Suranjan Shil, resident of Mahipur Chak Bhagaban, P.O. Mahipur, P.S. Kumarganj, Dist. Dakshin Dinajpur, currently residing at Hatiyadanga, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri; and (ii) Suvankar Das (35/M), son of late Sukumar Das, resident of Gopalpur, P.O. Tajnagar, P.S. Sutahata Haldia, Dist. Purba Medinipur, currently residing at Bholanathpara, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri (address not verified), along with the following items seized as per the seizure list:

- (i) One white pick-up vehicle with a closed body displaying reg. no-WB-03D-7194 along with its ignition key.
- (ii) 69 (Sixty Nine) sealed packet/cartoon box of Codeine Phosphate and Triprolidine Hydrochloride Syrup CHOCO+, each bottle containing 100 ml liquid Syrup, having batch no- POSLG094, Mfg. Date-10/2025, Exp. Date-09/2027, M.R.P-197.00, Manufactured in India by LABORATE PHARMACEUTICALS INDIA LTD. (Unit-II), #31, Rajban Road, Nariwala, Paonta Sahib (H.P), each carton containing 160 (One hundred and Sixty) bottles of Codeine Phosphate and Triprolidine Hydrochloride Syrup CHOCO+ and marked as exhibit "A-1 to A-69" recovered from the possession of the accused persons. (Total bottles-11040 bottles amounting to Rs. 11040x197= Rs. 2174880/ and total 11040x100=110400 ml)
- (iii) One loose carton box containing 91(Ninety-one) bottles of Codeine Phosphate and Triprolidine Hydrochloride Syrup CHOCO+, each bottle containing 100 ml liquid Syrup having batch no-POSLG094, Mfg. Date-10/2025, Exp. Date-09/2027, M.R.P-197.00, Manufactured in India by LABORATE PHARMACEUTICALS INDIA LTD. (Unit-II),#31, Rajban Road, Nariwala, Paonta Sahib (H.P), and marked as exhibit "B" recovered from the possession of the accused persons. (Total-91 Bottles amounting to Rs. 91x197= Rs. 17927/). [Total bottles- 11040+91=11131 bottles and total 11131x100=1113100ml]
- (iv) One F11-blue colour OPPO mobile phone having IMEI No. 868632045702330/868632045702322 with SIM no 7605850609, marked as Exhibit-C. Recovered from the possession of the accused Suvankar Das.
- (v) One white colour OPPO F-31 pro 5g mobile phone having IMEI No. 865761072708416/865761072708408 with SIM no- 9749633209, marked as Exhibit-D. Recovered from the possession of the accused Kanay Shil.

I, SI Ajen Lepcha s/o Lt. Dup Tshering Lepcha of Ashighar OP under Bhaktinagar PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above noted arrested accused persons to the effect that today on 18/12/25 at about 12:35 hrs I received a specific source input from my source that two individual suspects are waiting at Uttar Ektiashal under Ashighar OP in a white pickup medicine container vehicle and they have in their possession some articles suspected to be narcotic substance for delivering the same to their designated customers.

Accordingly, the matter was diarised vide Ashighar OP GDE No. 520 dated 18/12/2025, and I informed the matter to the Officer-in-Charge of Ashighar OP under Bhaktinagar PS, S.P.C. Subsequently, as per his kind direction, a raiding team was formed consisting of SI Amit Saiba, ASI Dinesh Ch. Roy, ASI Hasibul Hoque, C/970- Bikash Roy and C/1547 Prabir Das, all of Ashighar OP, S.P.C., being headed by me, and we left for Uttar Ektiashal under Ashighar OP by Govt. vehicle No.WB-42-8829 with investigation kit to verify the veracity of the information in hand vide Ashighar OP GDE No. 521 dated 18/12/2025 and M.C.C. No. 2199/25 dated 18/12/25 at 13:05 hrs. Thereafter, I contacted the videographer, namely Sunil Sarkar, aged 49 years, s/o-Late Nabadeep Sarkar, resident of North Shantinagar, Bowbazar, Siliguri, (Mobile No-7865908330), to come at Uttar Ektiashal to videograph the audio-video record of the whole process of search and seizure, if any.

On the way to Uttar Ektiashal, I contacted with two local witnesses namely Uday Sarkar, aged 19 years, s/o Lt Uttam Sarkar, resident of Khai Khai Bazar, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri and Raju Roy, aged 32 years, s/o- Dulal Roy, resident of Uttar Ektiyashal, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri and requested them to remain present with us as independent witness if any search, seizure be made. They expressed their willingness to remain present with us as independent witnesses. Under these circumstances, any search warrant or authorisation cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidence or facility for the escape of the offender.

At around 13:35 hrs we reached near Uttar Ektiashal beside under construction Green Valley Apartment under Bhaktinagar PS and met with the source. After a while, the source indicated that the individual suspects were inside a white pickup vehicle. Accordingly, as per his indication and identification, we detained a white pick-up vehicle with a closed body displaying reg. no-WB-03D-7194. We found two people inside the vehicle, one seated in the driver's seat (Kanay Shil) and the other in the passenger seat (Suvankar Das). Then, after disclosing our identity, we detained the above-noted two suspects with a strong reason to believe that they were illegally possessing, carrying and dealing with Narcotic substances in their joint possession for selling the same to their designated customers for their wrongful gain. On being asked, they disclosed their identity as (i) Kanay Shil (30/M), S/O- Suranjan Shil, R/O-Mahipur Chak Bhagaban, P.O-Mahipur, P.S- Kumarganj, Dist- Dakshin Dinajpur, A/P residing at Hatiyadanga, PS-Bhaktinagar, Dist-Jalpaiguri and (ii) Suvankar Das (35/M), S/O- Lt Sukumar Das of Gopalpur, P.O- Tajnagar, P.S- Sutahata Haldia, Dist- Purba Medinipur, A/P residing at Bholanathpara, PS-Bhaktinagar, Dist-Jalpaiguri (not verified). During interrogation, they first denied possessing any narcotic substance in person or in the vehicle they were in. But after prolonged interrogation, they ultimately admitted that they had illegal cough syrup in their joint possession in the vehicle and had been waiting there to deliver the same to their designated customers. I then gave them the option in writing whether they wanted to be searched in the presence of a Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer. They agreed to be searched by any one of them. I served them notice in accordance with the provisions of law in this regard. Subsequently, I informed the matter to the OC, Ashighar OP, and then, as per his direction, I sent ASI Dinesh Chandra Roy to Bhaktinagar PS with a requisition to Shri Amit Adhikary, Inspector-in- charge of Bhaktinagar PS, SPC, intimating the apprehension of two persons, namely Kanay Shil and Suvankar Das, suspected to be possessed with narcotic substance and requested him to come to Uttar Ektiashal beside under construction Green Valley Apartment under Bhaktinagar PS to supervise the process of search and seizure procedure, being a Gazetted Officer.

Accordingly, at around 14:17 hrs, Shri Amit Adhikary, Inspector-in-charge of Bhaktinagar PS, SPC, arrived at the spot, and I disclosed his identity to the detained persons as a Gazetted Officer. I also offered the independent witnesses and the apprehended persons to search our Police Party as per provision of the law, but they denied searching the police party.

Following that, in the presence of the Gazetted Officer Shri Amit Adhikary, Inspector-in-charge of Bhaktinagar PS, SPC and two independent witnesses, I searched the detained persons, including their vehicle, following all legal formalities and recovered (ii) 69 (Sixty Nine) sealed packet/cartoon box of Codeine Phosphate and Triprolidine Hydrochloride Syrup CHOCO+, each bottle containing 100 ml liquid Syrup, having batch no-POSLG094, Mfg. Date-10/2025, Exp. Date-09/2027, M.R.P-197.00, Manufactured in India by LABORATE PHARMACEUTICALS INDIA LTD. (Unit-II), #31, Rajban Road, Nariwala, Paonta Sahib (H.P), each carton box containing 160 (One hundred and Sixty) bottles of Codeine Phosphate and Triprolidine Hydrochloride Syrup CHOCO+ and marked as exhibit "A1 to A69" from the possession of the accused persons. (Total bottles-11040 bottles amounting to Rs. 11040x197= Rs. 2174880/) and (iii) One loose carton box containing 91(Ninety-one) bottles of Codeine Phosphate and Triprolidine Hydrochloride Syrup CHOCO+, each bottle containing 100 ml liquid Syrup having batch no-POSLG094, Mfg. Date-10/2025, Exp. Date-09/2027, M.R.P-197.00, Manufactured in India by LABORATE PHARMACEUTICALS INDIA LTD. (Unit-II),#31, Rajban Road, Nariwala, Paonta Sahib (H.P), and marked as exhibit "B" recovered from the possession of the accused persons. (Total-91 Bottles amounting to Rs. 91x 197= Rs. 17927/). [Total bottles-11040+91=11131 bottles]. Further, two mobile phones, i.e. (i) One F11 blue colour OPPO mobile phone having IMEI No. 868632045702330/868632045702322 with SIM no-7605850609 was recovered from the possession of suspect Suvankar Das, and (ii) One white colour OPPO F31 pro mobile phone having IMEI No. 865761072708416/865761072708408 with SIM no-9749633209, was recovered from the possession of suspect Kanay Shil.

On demand in presence of the Gazetted Officer and the independent witnesses they failed to produce any valid document in support of possessing of that substance suspected to be Narcotic substances which they were carrying using that vehicle. On further interrogation, they confessed that they procured the cough syrup clandestinely from Gandhinagar area of Siliguri for the purpose of delivery the same to their designated customers at different places of Siliguri as per their requirement for their personal gain by illegal means. They also disclosed that they have been dealing in such a business of selling the cough syrup illegally for a long time. Thus, when their involvement in carrying, possessing and dealing with cough syrup was established, I seized the above-noted articles, including one white pick-up vehicle with a closed body displaying reg. no-WB-03D-7194 along with its ignition key from the exclusive joint possession of the above-noted accused persons at the spot under proper seizure list in the presence of the IC Bhaktinagar as well as the independent witnesses as noted above and duly acknowledged by the accused persons and marked the seized articles viz. as Exhibit-A-1 to A-69, B, C, D respectively. Subsequently, I labelled the seized articles in the presence of the IC Bhaktinagar and the independent witnesses and the accused persons, as noted above.

From the above noted facts and seizure of incriminating articles, it is quite evident that the accused persons Kanay Shil and Suvankar Das are involved in procuring, possessing, carrying and dealing with cough syrup illegally and contravening the norms of the NDPS Act.

Thereafter, I arrested the above-noted accused persons Kanay Shil and Suvankar Das after observing all legal formalities as well as after communicating to them the grounds of arrest in writing, as they have committed a cognizable offence in the presence of Police Officers for possessing & carrying a substance suspected to be narcotic substance. The arrest information of the accused persons has been duly communicated to their family/relatives, namely Shantana Shil (F/25), W/O-Kanay Shil of R/O- Mahipur Chak Bhagaban, P.O- Mahipur, P.S- Kumarganj, Dist- Dakshin Dinajpur, at present residing at Hatiyadanga, PS-Bhaktinagar, Dist-Jalpaiguri (Mobile No-9339325760) and Siddhartha Shankar Das s/o-Lt Ramprasad Das of Gowaberiya of P.S- Sutahata Haldia, Dist- Purba Medinipur (Mobile No-9775767874), respectively. The process of search, seizure, and arrest was made between 14:17 hrs and 17:20 hrs on 18/12/2025.

Under the above noted facts and circumstances, I request to you that a specific case under proper sections of law may kindly be started against the involved arrested accused persons namely (i) Kanay Shil (30/M), S/O- Suranjan Shil, R/O- Mahipur Chak Bhagaban, P.O- Mahipur, P.S- Kumarganj, Dist- Dakshin Dinajpur, A/P- residing at Hatiyadanga, PS-Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri and (ii) Suvankar Das (35/M), S/O- Lt Sukumar Das R/O- Gopalpur, P.O- Tajnagar, P.S- Sutahata Haldia, Dist- Purba Medinipur, A/P residing at Bholanathpara, PS-Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
