

Request for registration of a case against unknown cattle smugglers.

Sir

Based on specific information received from the Coy Commander those smuggled from Nepal likely to be transported from AH-02 to Srirampur border Assam, reacting to this information a QRT was deployed near Sanyasi Road under the command of UIN-13090118, SI (GD) Bhrigunath parasad, along with 07 personnel, on the night of 30/04/2026. After proper briefing, the party commenced surveillance of the area.

At approximately 0055 hrs. the QRT observed a vehicle approaching from Asian Highway-02 towards Sanyasi Road. The vehicle was signaled to stop; however, they did not comply and speed away. The party immediately started pursuit using the government vehicle Bolero Camper No. WB74BP9563.

After chasing for some distance, vehicle was found stopped near AH-02. Taking advantage of the darkness, the drivers abandoned the vehicles and fled towards the nearby village area.

A thorough search of the area led to the recovery of **twenty-eight (28) cattle, Buffalo (male) along with Eicher Pro 3019 (M/HSD) Veh no.WB 73 G 5977 Colour-New golden brown.**

As no independent witnesses were available at the spot, two personnel from the QRT were nominated as witnesses. A seizure memo was prepared in their presence and duly signed at 0130 hrs.

The seized of twenty-eight (28) cattle, Buffalo (male) along with Eicher Pro 3019 (M/HSD) Veh no.WB 73 G 5977 Colour-New golden brown. are being handed over to Bagdogra Police Station on 30/04/2026 at 02:15 hrs. for further necessary action
