Sub: Complaint against (1) Sri Rajen Sharma (2) Sri Binod Prasad, (3) Sri Bhusan Prasad and (4) Jai Prakash Gupta under Section 3(1)(f)(g)(q)(r)(s)/3(2)(va) of SCs & STs (POA) Act, 1989 and relevant section of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 as per provision of Rule 5(1) of SCs & STs (POA) Rules, 1995 r/w Clause 8 & 10 of the Guidelines to the Police Officers Investigating cases under SCs and STs (POA) Act, 1989 issued by the Additional Director General of Police-II, CID, W.B.

Sir,

This is to bring to your kind notice to the fact that I belong to a Scheduled Tribe community, and as such, the circumstances that arose before me in the recent past, I am constrained to lodge the instant complaint against the accused persons named hereinabove under the SCs and STs (POA) Act, 1989.

I own a landed property which has been butted and bounded under Plot No. 191, Khatian No. 9, Pargana Patharghata, Touzi No. 91, J.L. No. 48, admeasuring 0.17 Acre within the Mauza- Jaduvitarchat, under P.S.- Matigara at present Pradhannagar, District- Darjeeling, and the said landed property has been purchased from Smt. Kandri Munda @ Mundani, daughter of Late Chin Munda and wife of Late Jangluram Munda, who also happens to be a Scheduled Tribe (Munda) and hails from Village-Jaduvitarchat, P.S.-Matigara, now Pradhannagar, District- Darjeeling, on 29.08.2005, and the said landed property in question since then is under my possession. The sale deed has been duly registered for 0.17 Acre of land and subsequently mutated in the name of the undersigned for 0.11 Acres. Hence, the transaction has been in due adherence with provisions as laid down under the West Bengal Land Reforms Act, 1955.

I also want to point out that one Sri Suresh Munda was living in the land in question for many years. So, after purchasing that land, I gave him another piece of land and some money, where he has been currently residing with his family.

I am an illiterate person and by my dint of age I have learnt to sign only, hence, I, in good faith, gave the responsibility of registration and mutation of my land to one Mr. Rajen Sharma in the year 2005 immediately after purchase of land who presented the deed of conveyance before the Additional District Sub-Registrar, Matigara vide Deed Serial No. 4932/2005 dated 29.08.2005, however registration was completed only on 05.06.2023 and thereafter mutation was done on 07.07.2023.

On 25.04.2025, (1) Sri Bhusan Prasad and (2) Sri Binod Prasad, both sons of Sri Ramdas Prasad of Village, P.O. & P.S.- Sulhiapukhari, District- Darjeeling who belong to general caste came to my plot of land and with the help of some labourers started cutting down trees located on the said plot of land without having any authorization to do so. By the time I was informed about the incident, both the brothers had already brought down 5 to 6 trees and on resistance by the undersigned both brothers tried to show some forged documents i.e. Deed, ROR and alleged permission obtained under Section 14C of Chapter IIA of West Bengal Land Reforms Act, 1955 and thereafter realising their own misdeeds and fear of being caught they immediately run away from my landed property.

Then, about half an hour later, Sri Jai Prakash Gupta, son of Sushil Gupta residing under P.S.- Pradhannagar, Darjeeling, came to my plot of land and started abusing us in the name of our caste in full public view and threatened us with dreadful ramifications.

It is also placed on record that the said Rajen Sharma is also an active land agent/mafia of the locality. It was then that I came to know that the aforesaid Rajen Sharma had kept my registration and mutation process pending for more than 18 years, meanwhile managing to sell my said plot of land to Sri Bhusan Prasad and Binod Prasad, without my knowledge.

Sri Rajen Sharma, under the garb of forged L.T.I. of Smt. Kandri Munda @ Mundani allegedly obtained permission on 01.03.2007 from the Project Officer-cum-District Welfare Office, Siliguri, in the name of an illiterate aged widow, Smt. Kandri Munda @ Mundani to sell off the landed property in question to Sri Bhusan Prasad and Binod Prasad, and presented the deed of indenture on 28.03.2007; therefore, Sri Rajen Sharma cheated and misled the office of the P.O.-cum-D.W.O., Siliguri, the said Smt. Kandri Munda @ Mundani, as well as the office of Additional District Sub-Registrar, Matigara, with a false LTI and forged permission obtained under the garb of pirated L.T.I., which attracts Section 3(1)(f)(g)(q) of the SCs & STs (POA) Act, 1989.

Therefore, such interpolation and heavy concoction of land records that too belonged to a member of the Scheduled Tribe occurred behind the back of the undersigned on the strength of spurious and engineered documents and also by forging the L.T.I. of a poor tribal widow, Smt. Kandri Munda @ Mundani in the deed of said Prasad brothers, with the intention to dispossess the undersigned and his family members from enjoying the fruits of the said land.

The whole conspiracy has been hatched at the behest of said Rajen Sharma with the help of the Prasad brothers, which would be evident from the deed of conveyance dated 29.08.2005 made between Smt. Kandri Munda @ Mundani and the undersigned and the executed deed dated 28.03.2007, which was made in favour of the Prasad brothers, as the said Rajen Sharma has stood as a witness in both the indentures. I also came to know that the accused had forged my signature on the alleged documents prepared by them.

However, it is reiterated that Smt. Kandri Munda @ Mundani had never approached the office of the P.O.-cum-D.W.O., Siliguri, for the grant of permission under Section 14C of the WBLR Act, 1955, to sell her said land to the aforesaid accused persons. She has also given a wilful declaration dated 25.04.2025 written in Hindi language by declaring that she had sold her landed property only to Rupan Singh Kherwar, S/o Late Sovan Singh Kherwar and no one else neither she ever applied before the Revenue Officer (P.O.-cum-D.W.O., Siliguri) for grant of permission under Section 14C of Chapter IIA WBLR Act, 1955 to sell off her land to Bhusan Prasad and Binod Prasad (copy enclosed).

It would also appear from the reply of the Revenue Officer (P.O.-cum-D.W.O., Siliguri) on an application made under the RTI Act, 2005, that permission was granted in favour of Smt. Kandri Munda @ Mundani under Section 14C of Chapter IIA of WBLR Act, 1955, for the sale of her land to Bhushan Prasad and Binod Prasad, which was already sold by her in favour of the undersigned, and till then, I am in peaceful possession of the said landed property. The reply provided by the Revenue Officer (P.O.-cum-D.W.O., Siliguri) vide Memo No. 1474/BCW dated 18.06.2025, and the order of permission dated 01.07.2007 are enclosed for your ready reference.

It is stated in the said permission order that Kandari Munda has taken an advance of Rs. 8,00,000 (Rupees Eight Lakhs) and a bank check/demand draft of Rs. 4,95,455 from the alleged buyers, but Kandari Munda herself has confirmed/declared that she has not received any money from the alleged buyers till date. She has also not built a house in Mauza Jaduvar, where the elderly woman lives with her disabled son.

The land in question is surrounded by a concrete wall and a gate, which was locked by Sri Rajen Sharma, Sri Binod Prasad and Sri Bhusan Prasad after they came to the land on 21.12.2025 at night.

Therefore, a serious breach of trust and injustice caused to a person belonging to a tribal community and such actions on the part of persons belonging to general caste who have hatched the entire conspiracy to dispossess a tribal person from his land causing him humiliation, annoyance and mental injury and forces him to seek legal remedies for the causalities caused by accused person is enough to take serious cognisance of the offences committed under Section 3(1)(f)(g)(q)(r)(s)/3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and like accused persons be brought to justice at once.

In that view of the matter, I most fervently request your goodself to register an F.I.R. against the said (1) Rajen Sharma (2) Bhusan Prasad, (3) Binod Prasad and (4) Jai Prakash Gupta under Section 3(1)(f)(g)(q)(r)(s)/3(2)(va) of the SCs & STs (POA) Act, 1989 as amended till date and relevant Sections of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 as per provision of Rule 5(1) of SCs & STs (POA) Rules, 1995 read with amended Rules, 2016 and Clause 10 of the Guidelines to the Police Officers Investigating cases under SCs & STs (POA) Act, 1989 issued by the Additional Director General of Police-II, CID, West Bengal and the Investigating Officer not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police may be appointed by the Commissioner of Police, Siliguri Police Commissionerate after taking into accounts his past experience, sense of ability and justice to perceive the implications of the case and investigate the SCs & STs atrocity case along with right lines within the shortest possible time who may file the Charge Sheet within 60 days showing full transparency and accountability in the working of public authority and may arrest the accused persons by the Investigating Officer immediately.
