WHEREAS, a message received from Sub-Divisional Officer, Siliguri vide Memo No. 179/Exam dated 10/04/2023 indicates that Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi is going to conduct **National Defence Academy (NDA), Naval Academy (NA)(I) and Combined Defence Services (CDS) (I) Examination, 2023** will be held on **16/04/2023 (Sunday)** from **09:00 hrs to 17:00 hrs** in **07 (Seven) Venues (List Enclosed)**, within the jurisdiction of Siliguri Police Commissionerate area;

WHEREAS, there is apprehension of breach of peace and tranquillity on the day of examination in the vicinity of the examination venues;

WHEREAS, it is felt expedient to pass certain directions to prevent obstructions, annoyance or injury to any person employed in connection with the examination and to prevent any danger to life, safety or disturbance to the examination and other persons;

WHEREAS, it is further felt expedient to arrange for speedy remedy in case of breach of peace and public tranquillity on the aforesaid day in and around the examination venue;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by sub sec (1) read with sub sec (3) of Sec. 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974) **I, Akhilesh Chaturvedi, IPS**, Commissioner of Police, Siliguri and Executive Magistrate in relation to the Metropolitan area of Siliguri and being empowered so to do by the State Govt. do hereby-

1. I in exercise of power conferred upon me U/S- 144 (2) Cr.P.C. I do hereby direct that 5(five) or more person, other than examinees, invigilator, support staff and such other person related to the said examination shall not assemble in the compound/ premises/ around the venue of said examination; and
2. Prohibit assembly of five (5) or more persons within the radius of 100 (one hundred) meters of the periphery of the examination venue within the Metropolitan area of Siliguri; and
3. Prohibit plying of loud speaker, microphone etc in and around 200 (two hundred) meters of examination venues. Use of Mobile Phones in an around 200 (two hundred) meters except the invigilators & venue in-charge is strictly prohibited; and
4. I do hereby also prohibit entrance of any person(S) except those concerned with the conduct of the said examination within the compound of the examination venue after the commencement of the examination till the completion; and

5. Prohibit all the Photo Copying Centres located within 100 meters from the examination venues on the day (16/04/2023) of examination from **07:00 hrs till examination process is over.**
6. Exigency of the situation does not allow me to serve the notice to the aggrieved parties, if any, and the order is passed ex-parte u/s 144 (2) of Cr.P.C of 1973.

Whereas, I, Commissioner of Police, Siliguri being the Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Siliguri, have been specially empowered by the State Government vide Home (Police) Department order No. 4297-PL/PB/4P-27/11 dt. 04.08.12 to act under the Section 144 of the said Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974).

And

Whereas, in my opinion, there is sufficient ground for proceeding under the said section for immediate prevention of disturbances of public tranquillity and breach of peace within the area-in-question of the Siliguri Police Commissionerate.

And

Now therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-section (1) read with sub sec (3) of Sec. 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974) read with the sub-Section (3) of the said Section, **I, Akhilesh Chaturvedi, IPS**, Commissioner of Police, Siliguri Police Commissionerate and Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Siliguri, do hereby prohibit for the period **60 (sixty) days from 28th April 2023 to 26th Jun 2023** until further order, any assembly of 05 (five) or more person in procession or the carrying of any lathi or other dangerous weapons or the doing of any act which is likely to cause disturbances to the public tranquillity and breach of the peace within the said area of NJP PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate.

FINAL ORDER PASSED BY SHRI JOY TUDU, IPS, DY. COMMISSIONER OF POLICE (HQ) SILIGURI POLICE COMMISSIONERATE IN C/W THIS UNIT PROCEEDING NO. 11/2019 DTD. 27/08/2019 DRAWN UP AGAINST ASI (UB) 1140 SANJIB SARKAR OF SILIGURI POLICE COMMISSIONERATE

ASI (UB) 1140 Sanjib Sarkar of Siliguri Police Commissionerate was charged with moral turpitude, indiscipline conduct and dereliction of duty unbecoming of a member of Police Force:-

The charge as drawn up against ASI (UB) 1140 Sanjib Sarkar is summarized below:-

While he (ASI (UB) 1140 Sanjib Sarkar) was posted at Khalpara TOP (TOP -II) under Siliguri PS, on 23/07/2019 evening at around 20.15 hrs he along with one other person namely Sumit Sarkar came to the shop of the Sunil Sharma (street side momo vendor) located opposite Heritage Hotel under Pradhannagar PS, in an intoxicated condition and demanded money from Sunil Sharma. On refusal he assaulted Sunil Sharma with fists and blows and took away cash and some golden ornaments from the person of Sunil Sharma. After that you took Sunil Sharma to the adjacent Pradhannagar TOP (since inoperative) and again assaulted him with bamboo lathi. Due to his such act, an L/O problem was created as the local people assembled and protested against such act of his, after that he let Sunil Sharma free. Subsequently Sunil Sharma was admitted to Siliguri Sadar Hospital on 23/07/2019 and discharged from the Hospital on 25/07/2019. Later, He (the charged officer) tell Sunil Sharma to settle the matter with Rs. 50,000/-, otherwise he will make a false case against him.

His act has tarnished the image of the Police Department in the eye of common people. Such moral turpitude, indiscipline conducts and unlawful activity showed an aberration from the ethics of a disciplined department and tantamount to infringement of Rule nos. 33 (a) & (b), 110 (A) (b) of P.R.B. 1943 read with Rule Nos 03 & 04 of West Bengal Govt. Servants' Conduct Rules, 1959.

The charged ASI (UB) 1140 Sanjib Sarkar received the copy of Charge & Statement of Allegation along with all relevant documents under his signature on 28.08.2019. In his written reply dated 02.09.2019, he did not plead guilty to the charges drawn up against him and preferred an open enquiry. The Proceedings File No. 11/2019 dated 27.08.2019 was endorsed to Shri Narendra Kalicotay, Assistant Commissioner of Police, SB, SPC as E.O. for the enquiry and submission of findings at an early date. On completion of enquiry, the E.O. Narendra Kalicotay, Assistant Commissioner of Police, SB, SPC submitted his findings on 15.04.2023.

I have carefully gone through the deposition of prosecution witnesses, Defence witness, contents of exhibits, written statement of defence and all other related papers pertaining to this departmental enquiry. During course of enquiry, the Enquiry Officer had examined as many as five P.Ws, two D.Ws and concerned six documents were referred to as exhibits. It is found that the enquiry was held as per rules and regulations and reasonable opportunity was also given to the Charged Officer to defend himself for the sake of natural justice. After weighing all documentary evidence, records, deposition of P.W.s the E.O. submitted his findings on 15.04.2023 with the opinion that the charge as drawn up against ASI (UB) 1140 Sanjib Sarkar is proved beyond any shadow of doubt. On 19.04.2023 the Charged ASI (UB) 1140 Sanjib Sarkar was heard by me personally, wherein he did not plead guilty.

After applying my mind judiciously, I agree with the findings of the E.O. and pass the Final Order as :-

“The Pay of the Charged ASI (UB) 1140 Sanjib Sarkar is withheld by 01 (one) increment from the next date of his due increment with cumulative effect.

Suspension period of the Charged ASI (UB) 1140 Sanjib Sarkar w.e.f. 29.07.2019 A.M. to 29.10.2019 P.M. is confirmed that means Charged officer will not get anything apart from subsistence allowance whatever he has drawn.”

As per Rule 883 of PRB Vol -I the Charged Const. is at liberty to appeal against this order before the Appellate Authority within 37 (thirty seven) days from the receipt of the copy of the Final Order.

Const-830 Pradip Roy of Siliguri Police Commissionerate was charged with moral turpitude, indiscipline conduct and dereliction of duty unbecoming of a member of Police Force.

The charge as drawn up against Const-830 Pradip Roy is summarized below:-

On the night of 07-08/06/2022 at around 02.10 hrs, some rowdies were harassing girls at Gurung Busty under the jurisdiction of Pradhannagar PS. On that night complainant Samiksha Rao along with her colleagues reached Pradhannagar PS to lodge complaints against the rowdies regarding the incident of violence and molestation. On that night, he (Const. 830, Pradip Roy) along with SI Krishna Parja and CV/ 993 Anil Das was performing K-30 night mobile van duty under Pradhannagar PS but his interaction with victims of molestation and violence was not courteous. One Anuj Suri, who was with the victim of incident told Const. 830, Pradip Roy that he (Anuj Suri) will go to the high authorities and report about his (Const. 830, Pradip Roy's) conduct. As a result, he became more furious and started shouting at all victims of molestation and violence. His conduct was unbecoming as the duty was not performed in the given manner, which amount to grave dereliction of duty.

The charged Const-830 Pradip Roy received the copy of Charge & Statement of Allegation along with all relevant documents under his signature on 30.06.2022. In his written reply dated 06.07.2022, he did not plead guilty to the charges drawn up against him and preferred an open enquiry. The Proceedings File No. 18/2022 dated 29.06.2022 was endorsed to Shri Santanu Tarafder, Assistant Commissioner of Police, AP, SPC as E.O. for the enquiry and submission of findings at an early date.

On completion of enquiry, the E.O. Shri Santanu Tarafder, Assistant Commissioner of Police, AP, SPC submitted his findings on 04.04.2023.

I have carefully gone through the deposition of prosecution witnesses, Defence witness, contents of exhibits, written statement of defence and all other related papers pertaining to this departmental enquiry. During course of enquiry, the Enquiry Officer had examined as many as nine P.Ws, concerned four documents were referred to as exhibits. It is found that the enquiry was held as per rules and regulations and reasonable opportunity was also given to the Charged Officer to defend himself for the sake of natural justice. After weighing all documentary evidence, records, deposition of P.W.s the E.O. submitted his findings on 04.04.2023 with the opinion that the charge as drawn up against Charged Const-830 Pradip Roy cannot be established and proved.

On 19.04.2023 the Charged Const -830 Pradip Roy was heard by me personally, wherein he did not plead guilty.

After applying my mind judiciously, I agree with the findings of the E.O. and pass the Final Order as:-

“After careful consideration of all the pros & cons of the proceedings file, the Charged Const-830 Pradip Roy is exonerated from the all charges as levelled against him and the Proceeding is **filed.**”

As per Rule 883 of PRB Vol -I the Charged Const. is at liberty to appeal against this order before the Appellate Authority within 37 (thirty seven) days from the receipt of the copy of the Final Order.

On completion of enquiry, Shri Gyalsen Lepcha , Assistant Commissioner of Police (Traffic HQ) SPC submitted his findings on 15.03.2023. I have carefully gone through the deposition of prosecution witnesses, contents of exhibits, written statement of defence and all other related papers pertaining to this departmental enquiry. During course of enquiry, the Enquiry Officer had examined as many as three P.Ws, concerned six documents were referred to as exhibits. It is found that the enquiry was held as per rules and regulations and reasonable opportunity was also given to the charged officer to defend herself for the sake of natural justice. After weighing all documentary evidence, records, deposition of P.W.s the E.O. submitted his findings on 15.03.2023 with the opinion that the charges levelled against her are proved beyond any shadow of doubt.

On 19.04.2023 the charged Officer was heard by me personally, wherein she did not plead guilty.

After applying my mind judiciously, I agree with the findings of the E.O. and pass the Final Order as :-

“The Pay of the Charged LASI (UB) 357 Sraboni Saha is withheld by 01 (one) increment from the next date of her due increment for 01 (one) year without cumulative effect.”

As per Rule 883 of PRB Vol -I the Charged Officer is at liberty to appeal against this order before the Appellate Authority within 37 (thirty seven) days from the receipt of the copy of the Final Order.

As per Rule 883 of PRB Vol -I the Charged Const. is at liberty to appeal against this order before the Appellate Authority within 37 (thirty seven) days from the receipt of the copy of the Final Order.
