Whereas, information has been received from reliable sources that smuggling and infiltration within 8 kms of Indo-Bangladesh International Border under Siliguri Police Commissionerate are causing / likely to cause grave danger to human life, property and public and a speedy remedy is necessary.

Now therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-section (1)(2) of Sec. 163 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (2 of 2023) **I, C. Sudhakar, IPS**, Commissioner of Police, Siliguri Police Commissionerate and Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Siliguri, do hereby prohibit movement of food grains and foodstuff i.e. rice, paddy, sugar, salt, wheat, pulses and other essential commodities and movement of trucks carrying cattle, livestock etc from 7-00 P.M each day to 6-00 AM next morning daily within 8 kms of Indo-Bangladesh International Border areas under Siliguri Police Commissionerate. The charge as drawn up Const -817 Anil Chhetri is summarized below:-

On 22/05/2022 one Raj Kumar Thakuri S/O Budhiman Thakuri of Gaiyabari Upper 20 Acres Hulak-Phubaguri, PS- Mirik Dist-Darjeeling lodged a written complaint before Officer-In-Charge Gorubathan PS against Const-817 Anil Chhetri alleging that his daughter namely Karishma Thakuri who was married with him was subjected to physical torture and ultimately she demised in the hospital on 21.05.2022. Consequently a Case was initiated against him (Const-817 Anil Chhetri) vide Gorubathan PS Case No. 13/22 dt-22.05.22 U/S-498 A /302 IPC. His complicity in the criminal case is against the ethics of a disciplined department and tarnished the image of Police Department.

The charged Const -817 Anil Chhetri received the copy of Charge & Statement of Allegation along with all relevant documents under his signature on 20.11.2022. In his written reply dated 24.11.2022, he did not plead guilty to the charges drawn up against him and preferred an open enquiry. The Proceedings File No. 25/2022 dated 15.11.2022 was endorsed to Shri Ashish P Subba the then Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), SPC as E.O. On his transfer the file was re-endorsed to Shri Somnath Das, Assistant Commissioner of Police (East-II), SPC for the enquiry and submission of findings at an early date. On Completion of enquiry, the E.O Shri Somnath Das, Assistant Commissioner of Police (East-II), SPC submitted his findings on 11.01.2025.

I have carefully gone through the deposition of prosecution witnesses, Defence witness, contents of exhibits, written statement of defence and all other related papers pertaining to this departmental enquiry. During course of enquiry, the Enquiry Officer had examined as many as 04 P.Ws, concerned 05 documents were referred to as exhibits and no D.W's was produced by the Charged Const. It is found that the enquiry was held as per rules and regulations and reasonable opportunity was also given to the Charged Constable to defend himself for the sake of natural justice. After weighing all documentary evidence, records, deposition of P.W.s the E.O. submitted his findings on 11.01.2025 with the opinion that Charge levelled against the Charged Const -817 Anil Chhetri has been proved in this enquiry beyond any doubt.

On 28.02.2025 the Charged Const -817 Anil Chhetri was heard by me personally, wherein he did not plead guilty.

After applying my mind judiciously, I agree with the findings of the E.O. and pass the Final Order as:-

"The pay of the Charged Const-817 Anil Chhetri is reduced by one increment for one year i.e w.e.f 01.03.2024 to 28.02.2025 without cumulative effect. The increment of the Charged Constable should be deducted in four (04) equal installments w.e.f- 01.03.2025 to 30.06.2025.

His Suspension period of the Charged Const -817 Anil Chhetri w.e.f. 22.05.2022 P.M. to 29.11.2022 P.M. is confirmed that means

Charged Constable will not get anything apart from subsistence allowance whatever he has drawn."

As per Rule 883 of PRB Vol -I the Charged Const. is at liberty to appeal against this order before the Appellate Authority within 37 (thirty seven) days from the receipt of the copy of the Final Order.

Sarkar] of Siliguri PC was detailed to perform Chaat Puja duty at Kawakhali Ghat under NJP PS, SPC vide NJP PS CC No- 406/24 Dated-07.11.2024 & Dated-08.11.2024 but he did not turn up at his duty posts till 02:45 AM as marked by Shri Somnath Das, ACP (East-II), SPC.

The charged officer SI (UB) Niranjan Ch. Sarkar received the copy of Charge & Statement of Allegation along with all relevant documents under his signature on 27.02.2025. He submitted his written explanation on 27.02.2025, wherein he has pleaded guilty to the charge drawn up against him.

In view of all that has been stated above, it is evident that the Charged Officer is guilty of the charges framed against him in the departmental proceeding. He himself has pleaded guilty, which has confirmed that his admission of guilt is at his freewill after being fully aware of the charges and implication of his admission. Last but not the least, the documents having exhibited and confirmed by a prosecution witnesses concerned make it beyond all reasonable doubt as to the guilt of the Charged Officer of all the charges. Considering the charges and his past service records, he should be meted out with punishment.

On 28.02.2025 the Charged officer SI (UB) Niranjan Ch. Sarkar was heard by me personally, wherein he pleaded guilty.

After applying my mind judiciously, I pass the Final Order as:-
"The pay of the Charged officer SI (UB) Niranjan Ch. Sarkar is immediately reduced by one increment for six months w.e.f- 01.11.2024 to 30.04.2025 without cumulative effect.

Suspension period of the Charged SI (UB) Niranjan Ch. Sarkar w.e.f. 30.12.2024 P.M. to 07.01.2025 P.M. is confirmed that means Charged Officer will not get anything apart from subsistence allowance whatever he has drawn. "

As per Rule 883 of PRB Vol -I the Charged Officer is at liberty to appeal against this order before the Appellate Authority within 37 (thirty seven) days from the receipt of the copy of the Final Order.

The charge as drawn up LASI (UB) 332 Tania Roy is summarized below:-

While being posted at Pradhannagar PS under Siliguri Police Commissionerate on 28.06.2024 she [LASI (UB) 332 Tania Roy] was detailed to perform second shift GDE duty from 14.00 hrs to 22.00 hrs. She took up the duty under the influence of liquor and found misbehaving with the complainant and refuse to entertain their complaints. When second officer of Pradhannagar PS, SI (UB) Bhaskar Kar asked her not to misbehave with the complainants, she showed the bad temper and utter slang to your senior officer. All this matter was report before Shri Basudeb Sarkar, I/C Pradhannagar PS, SPC. When he came at the GD table she was not found at the duty post and asking about her presence to LASI (UB) 720 Mithu Kabiraj and sentry Const-476 Jagat Ch Roy they both indicate the nearby rest room. Then Shri Basudeb Sarkar, I/C Pradhannagar PS, LASI (UB) 720 Mithu Kabiraj, SI (UB) Bijay Sarkar went to the room where she was found sleeping in full uniform. LASI (UB) 720 Mithu Kabiraj called her but she did not responded. Later on she left the P.S without informing IC Pradhannagar PS or any other officer of PS. Being member of the disciplined department her act was against the ethics of a disciplined department and tarnished the image of Police Department.

The charged LASI (UB) 332 Tania Roy received the copy of Charge & Statement of Allegation along with all relevant documents under his signature on 29.10.2024. In her written reply dated 05.11.2024, she did not plead guilty to the charges drawn up against her and preferred an open enquiry. The Proceedings File No. 23/2024 dated 21.10.2024 was endorsed to Shri Debasish Bose Assistant Commissioner of Police (Detective Department), SPC as E.O. for the enquiry and submission of findings at an early date. On Completion of enquiry, the E.O Shri Debasish Bose Assistant Commissioner of Police (Detective Department), SPC submitted his findings on 18.02.2025.

I have carefully gone through the deposition of prosecution witnesses, Defence witness, contents of exhibits, written statement of defence and all other related papers pertaining to this departmental enquiry. During course of enquiry, the Enquiry Officer had examined as many as 05 P.Ws, concerned 03 documents were referred to as exhibits and no DWs was produced by Charged Officer. It is found that the enquiry was held as per rules and regulations and reasonable opportunity was also given to the Charged Officer to defend herself for the sake of natural justice. After weighing all documentary evidence, records, deposition of P.W.s the E.O. submitted his findings on 18.02.2025 with the opinion that Charge levelled against the LASI (UB) 332 Tania Roy has been proved in this enquiry beyond any doubt.

On 27.02.2025 the Charged LASI (UB) 332 Tania Roy was heard by me personally, wherein she did not plead guilty.

After applying my mind judiciously, I agree with the findings of the E.O. and pass the Final Order as:-

“The pay of the Charged LASI (UB) 332 Tania Roy is reduced by one increment with cumulative effect.”

As per Rule 883 of PRB Vol –I the Charged Officer is at liberty to appeal against this order before the Appellate Authority within 37 (thirty seven) days from the receipt of the copy of the Final Order.
