WHEREAS, information received from the Additional Director General & Inspector General of Police, Law & Order, West Bengal vide Memo. No. 84 (3)/CR Dated 30.04.2025 & Memo No. 85 (3)/CR Dated 30.04.2025 arose from DO No. 29/11 (2)/2025-EIA (I) Dated 28.04.2025 of the Secretary, UPSC, New Delhi and further letter received from the Sub- Divisional Officer, Siliguri vide Memo No. 303/Exam Dated 14.05.2025 indicate that the Civil Services (Preliminary) Examination, 2025 conducted by the Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi to be held on **25.05.2025 (Sunday) from 09:30 hrs to 11:30 hrs and 14:30 hrs to 16:30 hrs in 09 (nine) Venues (List enclosed) within the area of Siliguri Police Commissionerate. Total 4079 (Four Thousand & Seventy Nine) Candidates** are supposed to appear in the said Examination;

WHEREAS, there is apprehension of breach of peace and tranquillity on the day of examination in the vicinity of the examination venues;

WHEREAS, it is felt expedient to pass certain directions to prevent obstructions, annoyance or injury to any person employed in connection with the examination and to prevent any danger to life, safety or disturbance to the examination and other persons;

WHEREAS, it is further felt expedient to arrange for speedy remedy in case of breach of peace and public tranquillity on the aforesaid day in and around the examination venue;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by sub sec (1) read with sub sec (3) of Sec. 163 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (2 of 2023) **I, C. Sudhakar, IPS**, Commissioner of Police, Siliguri and Executive Magistrate in relation to the Metropolitan area of Siliguri and being empowered so to do by the State Govt. do hereby-

1. I in exercise of power conferred upon me U/S- 163 BNSS I do hereby direct that **5 (five) or more person**, other than examinees, invigilator, support staff and such other person related to the said examination shall not assemble in the compound/ premises/ around the venue of said examination; and

2. Prohibit assembly of **five (5) or more persons** within the radius of 100 (one hundred) meters of the periphery of the examination venue within the Metropolitan area of Siliguri; and

3. Prohibit plying of loud speaker, microphone etc in and around 200 (two hundred) meters of examination venues. Use of Mobile Phones in an around 200 (two hundred) meters except the invigilators & venue in-charge is strictly prohibited; and

4. I do hereby also prohibit entrance of any person(S) except those concerned with the conduct of the said examination within the compound of the examination venue after the commencement of the examination till the completion; and

5. Prohibit all the Photo Copying Centres located within 100 meters from the examination venues on the **day (25/05/2025)** of examination from **07:00 hrs till examination process is over**.

6. Exigency of the situation does not allow me to serve the notice to the aggrieved parties, if any, and the order is passed ex-parte u/s 163(2) of BNSS of 2023.

Whereas, I, Commissioner of Police, Siliguri being the Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Siliguri, have been specially empowered by the State Government vide Notification No. 1548/1(8)-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-42/14 dated 16/08/2024 of Senior Deputy Secretary to the Govt. of West Bengal.

And

Now therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-section (1)(3) of Sec. 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita of 2023, I, C. Sudhakar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Siliguri Police Commissionerate and Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Siliguri, do hereby order that “No drone shall be flown within a distance of 05 (five) km from the periphery of Bagdogra Airport (Air Force Station) under Bagdogra PS Siliguri Police Commissionerate.”.

Exigency of the situation does not allow me to serve the notice to the aggrieved parties, if any, and order is passed ex-parte u/s 163(2) of BNSS of 2023.

This order will take into immediate effect and will remain in force till the completion of the proposed visit.

As per provision of Rule 861 of Police Regulation of Bengal (PRB),1943,Shri Sayem Ur Rahaman, Inspector of Police Commissionerate,the then MTO, Kalimpong District was charged with lack of misappropriation of public money during Lok Sabha Election 2019 in the following manner that.

1.As against the head of expenditure "Hiring charges for hiring of vehicles an amount of Rs.33,77,632/-(Thirty three lakh seventy seven thousand six hundred thirty two)was drawn by DDO Kalimpong during the Lok Sabha Election 2019.As per the written break p as submitted by him as MTO, the entire amount was spent for that particular purpose but no-records whatsoever in respect of the expenditure could be found either at the MT Section, Kalimpong or Police Office, kalimpong.

2. As against the head of expenditure "Cost of P.O.L for hired vehicles (private/Public) " an amount of Rs.63,66068/-(sixty three lakh sixty thousand sixty eight)was drawn by DDO Kalimpong during the Lok Sabha Election 2019.As per the written break up submitted by him, as the then MTO, the entire amount was spent on the above head. The only record available for expenditure incurred was an updated register found at the MT Section, bearing signature of the then DDO, Dy.SP (Hqrs),RI and MTO. The Register shown an expenditure of Rs. 70,07,746/-(Seventy lakh seven thousand seven hundred forty six) which was an excess of Rs,6,44,178/-(Six Lakh forty four thousand one hundred seventy eight) than what was received. This shows manipulation/ manufacturing of false records.

3. As against the head of expenditure " Khoraki charges to Drivers/ Khalasis of hired vehicles (private/public)" an amount of 6,65040/- (Six lakh sixty five thousand forty) was received/drawn by DDO kalimpong . An amount of Rs.6,62963/- (Six lakh, Sixty two thousand nine hundred sixty three) was shown to have been incurred as expenditure as per written break up submitted by him , as then MTO,Kalimpong. In this regards, 54 khoraki Rolls were found, duly signed by the then unit-in-charge and dated between 11/04/2019 and 22.05.2019, for an amount of Rs. 6,13,190/-(Six lakh thirteen thousand one hundred ninety). He failed to produce any record relating to expenditure of the rest of amount of Rs.51,850/-(Fifty one thousand eight hundred fifty).

Being a public servant entrusted with public money he indulged himself in unscrupulous practices in the form of making of false records/ bills etc. Which in unbecoming of a police officer and was violative of rule 3 and 4 of West Bengal Government Service Conduct Rule 1959.

The Charged officer was provided with the copies of the Charge, Statement of Allegation along with other connected/ relevant documents vide this Memo No.12-Pres-II/Pers-II.108/2023 (PT-II) Dated 15.01.2024.

On receipt of the same ,, the Charged officer submitted his written explanation dated 29.01.2024 wherein he denied to the charges levelled against him and preferred and open enquiry.

According, Ms Aparajita Rai, IPS, Special Superintendent of police, Intelligence Branch, North Bengal was appointed as the Enquiry officer in enquire into the instant proceeding enquiry vide this office Memo No.52-Pers-II-108/2023(PT.II)dated 12.02.2024. Later, Shri, Biswa Chand Thakur, IPS, Deputy Inspector General of Police, Traffic, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, West Bengal was appointed as the Enquiry Officer to enquire into the instant proceeding enquiry vide this office Memo No-66-Pers-II/Pers-II-108/2023 (PT-II) dated 29.02.2024 as the first E.O returned the proceeding File.

After completion of the enquiry, the Enquiry officer submitted his findings dated 03.05.2025 under his Office Memo No-1109/DCP/TRF/SPC/25 Dated 03.05.2025 wherein he opined that "no documental or oral evidence camp up which could unequivocally prove the charges of lack of integrity and misappropriation of public money levelled against the charged officer".

I have gone through all the relevant documents including the Charge, Statements of Allegation and the finding received from the Enquiry Officer, Considering every aspect together that came up in the enquiry report, I pass the following Final Order with an open and judicious mind.

"The instant Departmental Proceeding is hereby filed".
