Sir,

In producing herewith 21 (twenty one) bottles of liquors label as Himalayan Gold 60 up country sprit each bottles containing 600 ml. and 22 (twenty two) pieces of plastic glass kept in a plastic bag seized under proper seizure list from the house of one namely Bhusendra Nath Roy @ Bhusen Roy, s/o – Lt. Dharmeswar Roy of Menghora, PS- NJP, Dist: Jalpaiguri. I ASI Biswajit Adhikari of Milanpally OP under NJP P.S lodge this written complaint to the effect that on 04.03.21 at 15.30 hrs in course of spl. mobile van duty received a source information regarding the selling liquor at Menghora under Milanpally OP and informed the matter to O/C Milanpally OP and O/C NJP PS. As per direction of O/C Milanpally OP and O/C NJP PS myself along with accompanying force rushed to Menghora at the house of Bhusendra Nath Roy @ Bhusen Roy (50 yrs approx) vide Milanpally OP GDE No-100, Dt: 04.03.21. At 15.55 hrs reached at and as identified by the source and local people of Menghora conducted raid at the house owned by Bhusendra Nath Roy @ Bhusen Roy, s/o – Lt. Dharmeswar Roy of Menghora, PS- NJP, Dist: Jalpaiguri in presence of local witnesses. On search of the house a nylon bag containing 21 (twenty one) bottles of liquors label as Himalayan Gold 60 up country sprit each bottles containing 600 ml. was found which was kept conceal behind one wooden table.

Prior taking any steps, I waited for the arrival of the house owner till 17.05 hrs but none appeared. Accordingly in presence of witnesses I prepared seizure list and the nylon bag containing 21 (twenty one) bottles of liquors label as Himalayan Gold 60 up country sprit each bottles containing 600 ml. from the house owned by Bhusendra Nath Roy @ Bhusen Roy duly signed by the witnesses and left the spot. The seizure was made between 17.15 hrs to 17.35 hrs.

Under the above circumstances, I pray to your kind end for starting a specific case under proper section of law against the accused Bhusendra Nath Roy @ Bhusen Roy, s/o – Lt. Dharmeswar Roy of Menghora, PS- NJP, Dist: Jalpaiguri under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
