Sub: Complaint against my husband for his cruelty, dowry demand and bigamy

With due respect and humble submission I, **Smt. Sumita Bhujel**, Wife of Prem Kumar Bhujel & Daughter of Sri Badal Bhujel, presently residing at Debidanga Bazar, P.O. Champasari, P.S. Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling, have the honour to state the following for your kind perusal and necessary legal action please:

That sir, we (me and my husband Sri Prem Kumar Bhujel) were tied in marital knot on 01.05.2014 and after marriage we started to live as husband and wife at the resident of my above named husband at Tarabari, P.O. & P.S. Naxalbari, Dist. Darjeeling.

In the marriage my parents had provided a lot of ornaments and other valuable things as gifts but within a few days my husband started to raise demand of dowry. He firstly asked me for bringing money from my paternal home for starting our own business. I somehow convinced my parent and they had provided more about Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lac) only in cash in several instalment for construction of shop and to start a business of iron grill workshop. Moreover, the necessary equipments viz., welding machine, drill machine, dry machine etc, were also provided by my parent.

After starting the business my husband started to pressurize me for a new motor bike with an absurd plea that if the motorbike is available then the business can be developed within a short period. I denied placing such illogic demand with my parent but my husband started abusing me mentally and physically. Nevertheless, I did not share the matter with any of my paternal family member. But the physical and mental torture to me was gradually increasing. Ultimately I was bound to tell my relatives-in-laws but all went in vein.

Meanwhile, I thought if a two-wheeler might bring happy to my life then why not to try to do so. So, I persuaded my parents saying them that I am

facing difficulties in travelling as our house is at remote area and if a Scooty is available then not only for me but it will also be helpful for our new business.

Being convinced, my parent provided a Scooty but my husband instead of getting happy became annoyed. He asked me to return the Scooty immediately and to bring cash amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac) only in lieu of that as he wanted a new bike not the scooty. But, I refused to do so and on my denial response he had beaten me mercilessly with his powerful fist and kicks. I wanted to lodge the F.I.R. for his cruelty but the village people convinced me saying that lodging complaint in Police Station might result deterioration the relation between husband and wife. They also warned my husband for not repeating such incident or else all of them will take him to the police station for punishment.

On 29.03.2018 my husband during day time without any reason assaulted me brutally using his leather belt. I was suddenly attacked by him and before escaping from his claws I got severely injured in several parts of my body. I was not able to walk. The next day I somehow manage to go to Rural Hospital of Naxalbari for treatment.

For a few days after the aforesaid incident my husband was silent. But he again asked me to bring Rs. 1,50,000/- from my paternal home and when I denied to do so I was forcibly driven out of the home on 18.06.2018 with a dreadful threats saying as "If you want to join matrimonial life with me then to bring Rs. 1,50,000/- or else do not dare to come here again."

That since the date of driven out from the matrimonial home I have been residing with my parents at Devidanga Bazaar. I was hoping that being separated for a few months my husband would realize his wrong doing but all went in vein rather he used to threats me over phone. Ultimately I was left with no alternate except to take shelter of Court of law and filed a case vide Misc. Case No. 42/2019 with a prayer for protection and other relief under the provision of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005.

The case is pending before the Ld. Judicial Magistrate 4th Court at Siliguri but in the meantime my husband got married with another women (name not known) and presently living as husband and wife with the said women in his residence at Tarabari, P.O. & P.S. Naxalbari, Dist. Darjeeling.

In view of the above I humbly request you to lodge the matter as a complaint in your P.S. against my above named husband and kindly take a prompt legal action against him as he has committed crime of **cruelty** upon me, raising **demand of dowry** and also committed crime of **bigamy** so that I may get justice.
