Sub - FIR against Upen Das for placed hidden camera in the dress changing room.

Respected Sir,

I am Neha Rahman, D/o- Abdus Salam, Vill- Bitola, P.O- Mahendrapur, P.S- Harishchandrapur, Dist- Malda, Pin- 732125. I am the paramedical student (course- DRD, Batch - 2019-2021) of Anandaloke paramedical Institute (Anandaloke multispecialty Hospital & Neuroscience Centre), Parash Nagar, 2nd mile, Seroke road, Siliguri-734001. On 29th March 2021, I came to my hospital for doing my duty and classes as regular schedule. After completing my duty and classes, I went to change my uniform in the changing room, in our x-ray department at hospital. When I was entered in the changing room, at first I saw an uncertain water leakage from saline bottle which is put on a sidewall shelf (distance between changing room floor and the sidewall shelf approx 10ft). Then I called my batchmate Rishal Das in the uniform changing room to checkout, why water leakage happening. Rishal came into the changing room and stand on a chain to reach the shelfbar to fix water leakage from the saline bottle. After touching the bottle Rishal hand, the saline bottle, other equipment and one smart phone → page-1

were fallen on the floor. Then, I picked up the smartphone (Samsung company) and we saw on the smartphone that the video camera in recording mode (by the back camera). Suddenly I tapped on the stop button and approx 4 minutes of video were recorded on the smartphone and unfortunately, smartphone power button pressed and the smartphone display gets locked when. firstly, after entering into the changing room, I can't see the smartphone above the shelf in my naked eye, because the smartphone perfectly covered by the saline bottle.

In that situation, my batchmate Rishabh Das and I identified the mobile owner Upen Das, - S/o - Parindra Das, Address - Jallapara, Jalpaiguri, Barapatia, Nutanbus, West Bengal, 735121, Address No - 559727801804. Mobile no - 9641530280, (GDA - General Duty assistant, department of X-ray, Anandaloke Hospital), is the owner of the smartphone which was placed in a hidden position on the wall-side shelf in a video recording mode, and a video recorded on Upen Das smartphone. Then, Rishabh Das put the mobile on the shelf, we came out from that, why he put his smartphone above shelf in video recording mode?

Then Upen Das replied nothing, suddenly went into the changing room, Upen Das took his smartphone, felt nervousness and leave the

changing room immediately. After the incident, my batchmate Richab Das told me that, Mr. Upen Das went into the changing room 5 minutes before me. Then I discussed with my parents about the incident and day after I informed the institute principal, Paramedical Incharge, Department Incharge, in writing application on (30.03.2021). The next day, Hospital Institute created an emergency enquiry committee (on 31.03.2021) and taken some necessary action against accused Upen Das. Now, me and my parents want to file an FIR. against accused Upen Das.

On 1st April 2021 accused Upen Das came in Anandaloke Hospital and ^{Hospital} Emergency enquiry committee discussed with accused Upen Das and he confess in written and virvally in front of about the ~~er~~ happend crime, in front of enquiry committee. Then, enquiry committee hand over ~~to~~ accused Upen Das to HOD of HR - Mr. Subhomoy Rakshit - (mobile No - 9830808102) custody.

Then, police came in our Anandaloke Paramedical Institute to investigate and accus in that ~~at~~ time accused Upen Das was missing from the custody of HR HOD - Mr. Subhomoy Rakshit.

I want to that, the culprit to gets appropriate punishment.


