Respected Sir,

With due respect I, Sujit Poddar, S/O Late K.C. Poddar, resident of Hill View Residency, Pradhan Para, P.O. Sahagara, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist - Jalpaiguri, West Bengal begs to state that today at about 10:00 AM when I enquired about the fund of the Society of our residency and cash at the bank in presence of the other members of the society. The manager i.e., Swapan Kumar Dutta, S/O Late Suresh Chandra Dutta, resident of Bottal Company, Jyoti Nagar disclosed that he had taken Rs. 2,00,254/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Two Hundred and Fifty Four only) in cash of the society from the locker with the help of his son Suvojit Dutta. That Swapan Kumar Dutta in conspiracy with his son used to collect the monthly maintenance amount from the flat owners with an intention to cheat the flat owners and misappropriate the amount. That from the very beginning, when the flat owners used to pay the maintenance through cheque but he used to refuse to accept the same and he induced the flat owners to pay the maintenance amount in cash. On his inducement with an intention to cheat, the flat owners used to pay the maintenance amount in cash. That Swapan Kumar Dutta and his son from the very beginning used to steal money from the fund of the Society of the residency for their illegal gain. That Swapan Kumar Dutta and his son cheated with mala fide intention and on their inducement flat owners paid their valuable security. That Swapan Kumar Dutta himself confessed his guilt that he had misappropriated the fund and the said amount should be more than the confessed amount.

So I therefore request you to kindly look into the matter and do the needful under the provisions of law.

I shall be highly obliged for this act of kindness.
